The incumbent must deliver complete content for the online course(s) specified below in order for it to be offered for the Fall 2018 semester (pending Senate approval of the Online MEd program). The incumbent will do so in accordance with requirements established by the Faculty of Education Graduate Program Office and the Office of Open Learning (OOL).

The successful applicant will be required to attend two (2) half-day workshops on online course development that are offered by the OOL – to be offered in February. In addition, attendance at subsequent bi-weekly 1-hour ‘check-in’ sessions with OOL are also mandatory through the end of April.

As per WUFA Article 54:18 (Credit Courses Delivered through Alternative Learning Technology) and Article R.2 (Sessional Rates for Partial Courses), the following provisions apply:

- course development stipend of \$2500 will be paid
- the successful applicant will have opportunity to deliver this course the first two times it is offered online
