## SPRING 2024 CONVOCATION TIMELINE

The following is a summary of important dates to assist graduate students who are aiming at completing the research requirement for a PhD dissertation or a Master's thesis/major paper/ internship paper within Winter term 2024, and to graduate in the Spring 2024 convocation. The timeline leads to the oral Defense and a 3-step "Deposit" by the student of their final document to the graduate studies office.

- Students who complete the Deposit with the graduate studies office by May 13, 2024 will be eligible to graduate in the Spring 2024 convocation and will not be required to register in the dissertation/thesis/major paper/internship for Summer term 2024. The final grade will be assigned to the previous term, Winter term 2024.
- Students who complete the Deposit with the graduate studies office <u>after May 13, 2024 will not</u> be eligible to graduate in Spring 2024 convocation, and must register for Summer term 2024 in the dissertation/thesis/major paper/internship. The final grade for students who deposit after May 13<sup>th</sup> will be assigned to the current term, Summer term 2024. A 50% base tuition refund (Phase II) for Summer term 2024 is available for eligible students who complete the Deposit from May 14<sup>th</sup> to June 17<sup>th</sup>, 2024.
