

Work opportunities for Family Physicians/graduating Family Medicine Residents at Student Health Services, University of Windsor

The University of Windsor is a medium size university with presently about 16,000 students. Student Health Services (SHS) is a medical office on Campus. It is located on the second floor of the CAW Student Centre. Its' mission is to provide quality comprehensive primary health care to all the students in need. There are about 13,500-15,500 patient visits per year, depending on physician availability.

The clinic can accommodate 4 FTE physicians. It has 2 clinical nurses, 1 part time medical secretary, 1 part time medical transcriber, 2 receptionists, 2 part time consulting psychiatrist, a health promotion nurse and a secretary to the Director. An asthma educator and a BANA (Bulimia Anorexia Nervosa Association) counselor spend a few hours per week at the clinic seeing patients, depending on need.

Although the focus is on late adolescent and young adult health, SHS also serves many returning mature students (about 2,000) and about 1,900 international students from over 50 countries.
