Application Instructions for Nursing PhD Program

The following are the required application materials that must be submitted as part of your online application for the Nursing PhD program.

Note: All documents including references must be submitted by **January 15th**. Please complete the application **by beginning of December** to ensure all documents are received by the deadline.

1. **One completed on-line** application. Details can be found at www.uwindsor.ca/graduate.
2. **Three confidential reports** to be completed by referees who are academics/professionals.
Important: Apply a **minimum** of three weeks prior to the application deadline to ensure your referees complete the form by the application deadline.
3. **Curriculum Vitae (CV)**
4. **A statement of research interest and a career plan**
5. **Two examples of independent scholarly work (e.g., publications, research reports, course assignments)**
6. **Nurse Registration**. Applicants must be licensed/certified to practice as a registered nurse in a Canadian province or internationally.
7. **Official transcripts** of all undergraduate and graduate work from all colleges or universities attended.
Current or past University of Windsor students can print their transcripts through their myuwindsor.ca account. Official transcripts are not required for University of Windsor graduates.
8. **Certification of English Proficiency** for international students. Successful completion of an English Language Proficiency exam may be required. IELTS—minimum score: 7.0 or Canadian English Language Benchmark Assessment for Nurses (CEBAN): Minimum scores: Writing - 7; Speaking - 8; Listening - 10; Reading - 8.
