| Alumni Graduate Award | 1 or more | \$400 | Established in 1996 by the Faculty of Nursing Alumni, is awarded on the basis of scholarship and leadership to an MSc or MN student in nursing entering the final year of the program. |
| Dr. Sheila J. Cameron Award | 1 or more | \$1,200 | Established in 1996 by the Faculty of Nursing Alumni to honour the contributions of Dr. Sheila J. Cameron to the development of graduate education. Dr. Cameron was Director of the School of Nursing from 1986 to 1995. One or more awards for incoming MSc or MN student(s) in nursing are assigned on the basis of academic merit and leadership in nursing. All students accepted into the nursing graduate program will be considered for the award. |
| Yvette Miller Memorial Graduate Nursing Award | 1 | \$1,400 | Established in memory of Yvette Miller, a 1985 graduate of the BScN program. Awarded on the basis of academics and leadership to a student after successful completion of the first year of graduate studies in nursing. |
| Dr. Janet N. Rosenbaum Graduate Practicum Scholarship Fund | 1 | \$540 | Established in 1999 in honour of the contributions of Dr. Janet N. Rosenbaum. Awarded annually to a full-time graduate student on the basis of academic record and leadership after successful completion of the first year of graduate studies in nursing. |
| Chadwell-Horsburgh Family Award For Graduate Nursing Students | 1 | \$400 | Established in 2000 to honour two families who have made long-standing contributions to the community of Windsor/Essex. Awarded annually to a part-time MSc or MN student in Nursing who is a resident of Essex County. To be awarded on the basis of the applicant's academic merit and potential for scholarship. |
