## \$1,500 Tuition Prize Draw Rules

### Objective

The objective of this contest is to obtain feedback on student experiences at either Head Start 2019 or Mature, Transfer, Part Time Orientation 2019

### Rules and Regulations

1. Only individuals who have been offered admission for Fall 2019 to the University of Windsor are eligible to win the prize being offered. Winners must be new University of Windsor students registered in the Fall 2019 semester and in their first semester in their first year of an undergraduate program.
2. Individuals may only win one prize.
3. Winners will receive the \$1500 award in their UWindsor student account after **the last day to voluntarily withdraw from fall term courses** (November 13, 2019).

### The Rules of Engagement

- 1) The contest will begin at 9:00am everyday of Head Start on June 14<sup>th</sup>, July 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, and 13<sup>th</sup>, and August 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and will end the same day at 1:50 p.m. For the Mature/Transfer/Part-time Orientation, the contest will begin on August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019 at 5:00pm and end at 8:30pm the same day. The winner will be announced on August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019 via Instagram Live.
- 2) Throughout each of the above Head Start Days participants will have a chance to earn a ballot from staff member or volunteer from 9:00 a.m. until 1:50p.m by returning a completed the Head Start Assessment form to a staff member or volunteer. Those in attendance at Mature, Transfer, Part Time Orientation will be able to earn a ballot by submitting a Mature, Transfer, Part Time Orientation Assessment form to a staff member or volunteer between 5pm and 8:30pm on August 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
- 3) A prize draw for one \$1500 award towards a student's UWindsor account will be held on August 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
- 4) The winner will be notified the day of the draw and will be given further instructions on how to claim the prize.
- 5) Valid photo identification will be required to collect the prize (government issued ID).
- 6) The winner must answer a skill-testing question correctly when signing for their prize.
- 7) No purchase is necessary. Prize not redeemable for cash.
- 8) Information collected from ballots will be used solely for the purposes of selecting contest winners.
- 9) Students must stay registered in the fall semester until after the last day to voluntarily withdraw from Fall term courses (November 13, 2019) in order to receive the award. If a winner is deemed ineligible, the prize will be forfeited and another winner will not be chosen.
