

Summer Research Fellowship in Physics University of Windsor Windsor, ON, Canada

The Department of Physics at the University of Windsor offers the <u>Summer Research</u> <u>Fellowship for domestic students</u> registering in our research-based graduate programs in September. The experience that a summer research fellow will gain from the program will let you get a head start on your research project and increase chances of producing publications in the near future. These publications are important for future scholarship applications and prospective career goals.

Up to \$3,750 or \$1250/month in funding is available to start research in the summer before the official start date in September. Incoming students must stay full time for three months of the summer (May 15 –August 15). This will give Summer Research Fellows a chance to get a head start on their research work. This fellowship cannot be combined with any other source of research funding. Students may not take any course-work during this time period.

Eligibility:

In addition to being a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada, students must have:

- 1. received an offer of admission to our M.Sc. thesis, major paper, or Ph.D. graduate program
- 2. forwarded their signed Faculty of Graduate Studies Acceptance Form
- 3. submitted the Summer Research Fellowship Application form by April 30th to the Physics Department Office.

Application Form

The Department of Physics has a special summer research program for new, domestic graduate students. A stipend of \$3,750 (or \$1250/month) in funding is available to start your research in the summer before your official start date in September.

Eligibility:

You must

- have confirmed your acceptance of the offer of admission from the Department of Physics by April 30th;
- be accepted by a research supervisor; and your supervisor commits to summer research funding
- spend three months of full-time research between May 15th and August 15th;
- register in the Physics graduate program (MSc thesis option or PhD) in September (May and January starters are ineligible);
- be a Canadian citizen or a permanent resident of Canada.

Conditions:

- Students are not eligible to take any courses or use other facilities such as the athletics centre at the University of Windsor.
- Students are not eligible for the GSS dental or health benefits during this period.
