

Going Above and Beyond in Research Award (non-student)

A Faculty of Science Award

Application Deadline: Friday, March 1, 2024

Purpose:

To recognize and reward Science Research Associates, Post-Doctoral Fellows and Adjunct Faculty whose research has been outstanding and who have made significant strides both at the national and international levels. This award will recognize research success that exceeds typical expectations of the discipline.

Criteria:

The committee will be examining the application packages for evidence of (but not limited to):

- National/international research contributions (conferences, awards, publications)
- Research is novel, innovative and impactful, and thus has contributed significantly to the field of research and/or may potentially improve quality of life.
- Research that raises the profile & reputation of the Faculty of Science and University of Windsor.

Eligibility:

Any Faculty of Science Research Associates, Post-Doctoral Fellows and Adjunct Faculty. Nominees must not have received this award during the previous 5 years.

Nomination Process:

Nominations made by colleagues, students or through self-nomination.

Application Packages:

Application packages will include:

1. Nomination letter or application detailing the reasons for the submission.
2. One letter of support (letter must be from an individual other than the nominator)
3. CV

Application packages should be submitted electronically to:

Review Process:

Application packages will be circulated to the Award Committee electronically for individual review. The committee will then meet to discuss the applications and reach a final decision. The Award Committee will consist of the Associate Deans and Department Heads (or their designate).

Award:

The Award will be given to a maximum of two individuals each year. One award will be designated for each of these categories:

1. Science Research Associates or Post-Doctoral Fellows
2. Science Adjunct Faculty

Successful Research Associates & Postdoctoral Fellows will receive \$1,000 and a certificate. Successful Adjunct Faculty will receive a \$1,000 research grant and a certificate.
