

Going Above and Beyond in Research Award (Student)

A Faculty of Science Student Award

Application Deadline: Friday, March 1, 2024

Purpose:

To recognize and reward students whose research has been outstanding and who have made significant strides both at the national and international levels. This award will recognize research success that exceeds typical expectations of the discipline.

Criteria:

The committee will be examining the application packages for evidence of (but not limited to):

- National/international research contributions (conferences, awards, publications)
- Research is novel, innovative and impactful, thus has contributed significantly to the field of research and/or may potentially improve quality of life.
- Research that raises the profile & reputation of the Faculty of Science and University of Windsor.

Eligibility:

Any full-time Faculty of Science students (any level). Length of time in a PhD program may be taken into consideration when selecting recipients. Nominees must not have received this award during the previous 5 years.

Nomination Process:

Nominations made by Primary Investigators/Supervisors.

Application Packages:

Application packages will include:

1. Nomination letter by Primary Investigator/Supervisor (nomination letter should emphasize the nominee's role within the research project)
2. One letter of support (letter must be from an individual other than the nominator)
3. CV of Nominee

Application packages should be submitted electronically to:

Review Process:

Application packages will be circulated to the Award Committee electronically for individual review. The committee will then meet to discuss the applications and reach a final decision. The Award Committee will consist of the Associate Deans and Department Heads (or their designate), 1 undergraduate student and 1 graduate student.

Award:

The Award will be given to a maximum of one Undergraduate, one Master's, and one Doctoral student each year. Successful applicants will receive a \$1,000 and a certificate.
