Bylaw 5: AAU Heads

Bylaw 8: Associate Deans

If the second recommendation by the Search Committee is **either** not endorsed by the Faculty Coordinating Council, or in the case of a Faculty that has no departments the Faculty Council, **or is not accepted by the President**, the Search Committee shall be reconstituted.

~~2.4.5 If the candidate endorsed by the Faculty Coordinating Council, or in the case of a Faculty that has no departments the Faculty Council, is not accepted by the President, the Search Committee shall reconsider its recommendation. Bylaw 10: Deans of Faculties

Rationale:

- The proposed revisions simplify the wording and clarify the intent of the bylaw, which is that the Search Committee has two chances to recommend a candidate, after which the Search Committee is to be reconstituted.
