MOTION: That the following revisions to Bylaw 12 be approved:

- Vice-Provost, Students-Affairs and International-Dean of Students
- 2.1 "... reporting to the Provost, oversees the University's partnership with students, **and** works to foster and enhance the student experience, ~~and leads its international activities. ..."~~
- 2.3.3 "... whether it should recommend to the Senate a renewal without a search in light of the activities of ~~the Division of Student Affairs Development and Support, the Office of Liaison and Student Recruitment, the Office of the Registrar,~~ and any other area that may be placed within his/her ambit of management. ..."

Schedule A - Duties and Responsibilities

- act as Dean of Students, ~~International Liaison Officer,~~ and as executive head of Student ~~and International Affairs~~ and any other area that may be placed within his/her ambit of management; International Affairs, which for example may include:
 - ~~administering policies and procedures related to international student recruitment, admission, enrolment management, student records, and enrolment reporting; in support of efforts to ensure that the University can compete effectively at a global level to attract and retain the best international students and manage international student enrolment opportunities sustainably in the context of institutional and program capacity and priorities;~~
 - ~~encouraging the engagement of every academic program in international initiatives as they are appropriate to the discipline;~~
 - ~~fostering faculty, student and staff exchanges and placements, as well as co-op and internship opportunities, that offer an international experience;~~
 - ~~ensuring the implementation of Senate Bylaw(s) as they pertain to international affairs;~~
 - ~~promoting the University's academic programs and student services to the local, regional, national, and international communities, in collaboration with appropriate areas on campus.~~
 - ~~delivery of English support programs for second language students through the Centre for English Language Development.~~
