

MSW/JD—STEPS FOR ADMISSION AND REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

Step One: Submit an application to the University Of Windsor Faculty Of Law through the Ontario Law School Application Service (OLSAS) <http://www.ouac.on.ca/olsas/>

Check the box indicating the MSW/JD integrated program

Required documents for OLSAS Application for Windsor Law (also listed on the OLSAS website under Application Procedures)

- 1) OUAC/OLSAS application
- 2) University of Windsor Personal Profile
- 3) All official transcripts
- 4) Current official LSAT score report; LSAT scores written in the previous six years
- 5) Two (2) letters of reference (one academic and one non-academic) on the forms specifically provided for this purpose (available on the OLSAS website).

Step Two: When you have received confirmation from the University of Windsor Office of the Registrar that your application to the joint MSW/JD program has been received, included in that confirmation letter will be a list of additional documents that must be completed and returned to the Office of the Registrar to complete your application for the Joint MSW/JD program.

Additional Documents required for the MSW/JD application to be submitted directly to the University of Windsor Office of the Registrar (these documents are available on the University of Windsor School of Social Work Application for MSW programs <http://www.uwindsor.ca/socialwork/application-for-admission>)

- 1) A completed Application to the Master of Social Work Program
- 2) The Professional Experience Form for Admission to the Master of Social Work Program
- 3) Three completed School of Social Work Reference forms consisting of:
 - a. One academic
 - b. One employment
 - c. One from a helping professional (nurse, teacher, social worker)
- 4) A completed Personal Statement for the School of Social Work
- 5) The policy statement page returned with your signature and the current date
- 6) Evidence that you have completed a statistics course and a research course

NOTE: To complete your application to the joint MSW/JD program, you do not need to apply directly to the MSW program if you have specified your intent on OLSAS to apply for the joint program. The additional documents requested by the Office of the Registrar will complete your joint application. HOWEVER, if you wish to be considered for admission to the MSW program ONLY, in addition to the joint MSW/JD program, you must submit a second application to the MSW program following the instructions on the MSW website

This includes a two step process: 1) an application to the Faculty of Graduate Studies and Research, University of Windsor, which is completed through www.uwindsor.ca/grad and includes an \$85 application fee; and 2) an application to the Master of Social Work Program, School of Social Work, University of Windsor – all of the materials for this application can be found at <http://www.uwindsor.ca/socialwork/application-for-admission>
