APPEAL OF PARENTAL CONTRIBUTION: PARENTAL EXCEPTIONAL EXPENSES

If parental income is sufficiently high that a contribution is expected, the following expenses can be used to decrease the value of that contribution. **Note: Since an OSAP assessment is based on income received in a specific year, only expenses incurred in that same year can be used for this appeal**.

♣ Parent(s) Working in the U.S. and Filing Taxes in Canada and the U.S.

If the parent of a student is working in the U.S. and filing income taxes in Canada and in the U.S., the income tax liability by the parent to the U.S. may be considered as an exceptional expense to reduce the study period income contribution.

Supporting Documentation Required:

- A copy of the Notice of Assessment from Canada Revenue Agency for the taxation year being used in the OSAP assessment confirming the amount of the Foreign Tax Credit allowed;
- A copy of the Tax Return Transcript from the U.S.;
- A letter from the student's parent(s) explaining their employment situation.
