## **AWARDS FOR BUSINESS STUDENTS - 2017/18**

### **\$20,000 Yves Landry Memorial Scholarship (\$2,500 x 8 terms)**

Up to four awards will be available to students entering directly from an Ontario High School, in either the Business Administration or Engineering programs. Based on scholastic merit (minimum scholarship average of 85%), proven leadership potential through school and/or community involvement. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), residing in Ontario with demonstrated financial need. The award may be renewable in subsequent years of study provided the student maintains a minimum cumulative average of 80% and has proven financial need. This scholarship was established in 1998 in honour of the memory of Yves Landry, former executive head of Chrysler Canada. Apply on line.

### **Aileen and Eli Goldin Memorial Awards**

One or more annual awards to students, preferably in the Faculty of Business, in Year 2 or beyond, who are residents of Windsor. Assigned on the basis of academic merit (minimum cumulative average of 68%) and demonstrated financial need. Established in 1990 by friends of Aileen and Eli Goldin to honour their memory. If you have applied for the "University of Windsor In Course Bursary" by October 15 through this awards search, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **Alfie Morgan Award in Business Strategy**

Two awards available for Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), residing in Ontario, who are registered in the Odette School of Business in year 3 or 4 and have a minimum cumulative average of 72%. Applicants must demonstrate financial need. The recipient will have completed by the end of the current Winter term at least one of the following courses, International Business (04 75 393) or Entrepreneurship (04 75 290) with a B+. Whenever possible one award shall be granted to a student in International Business and the other to a student in Entrepreneurship. A letter demonstrating commitment to and aspirations in either International Business or Entrepreneurship should accompany the application. Apply on line.

### **Benson Financial Services Group, Sunlife Award**

Two awards granted annually on the basis of academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 73%) and financial need to a Year 2, 3, or 4 Business student, majoring in Accounting, Marketing, or Finance. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) residing in Ontario. Established in 1999 in honour of Michael Benson, of the Benson Financial Group. Apply on line. Deadline: October 31.

### **Certified Management Accountants/Dean Roger Hussey Scholarship in Strategic and Financial Management**

An annual scholarship awarded to a full time Odette School of Business student entering his/her third year of study in accounting, finance or strategy. Based on academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 75%), outstanding record of leadership and community involvement, a demonstrated strong interest in pursuing an accounting designation, and to be classified as a current Associate Member with CPA. Eligible candidates must be Canadian citizens or Permanent residents, residing in Ontario, and must have proven financial need. Apply on line. Deadline: October 31.

### **Commerce Class of 1964 Awards**

Up to four awards made annually to students registered in Year 2, 3 or 4 of the Bachelor of Commerce program. Based on participation in other campus and outside community activities, satisfactory academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 60% required).

Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) with proven financial need. Apply on line.

### **Commerce Class of '55 Award**

Annual awards for outstanding undergraduate and graduate students in Business Administration, awarded on the basis of combined academic excellence and extracurricular achievement. Apply by submitting a resume and letter of intent to [odettesuccess@uwindsor.ca](mailto:odettesuccess@uwindsor.ca).  
Deadline: July 31.

### **Costco Wholesale Leadership Scholarship in Business**

One award granted annually to a full time undergraduate student in Year 1 or 2 in Business Administration who is a graduate of a high school in Windsor or Essex County. Based on demonstrated leadership ability and community involvement. Financial need may be a consideration. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status). Apply online.

### **CPA Stream Scholarship**

Interest from this trust will support an annual award to a student registered in a Post Graduate Certificate or Graduate Program in Accounting. Based on academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 70% required) and financial need. To be considered, applicants must have an interest in pursuing a professional designation (CPA) in accounting and be registered with CPA Ontario. Applicants must submit a 500 word summary outlining your interest in the accounting profession, your involvement including in the OAA, the community, other on campus activities or professionally that has led to your academic success within the accounting concentration. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status). Apply online.

### **David Cornhill Alta Gas Scholarship**

Awarded to a full time student in either the Faculty of Business, Engineering or Science, who has demonstrated financial need. A minimum cumulative average of 83% is required. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), residing in Ontario. Preference will be given to a student from the Chatham/Kent area. Apply on line.

### **David Moore Memorial Scholarship**

Awarded annually to a fourth year Bachelor of Commerce student who is planning to pursue a career in chartered accountancy. Based on academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 75% is required), as well as active participation in extra-curricular and community activities. Established in 1995 through the Essex Kent Chartered Accountants Association by friends and colleagues of the late David Moore. Apply on line.

### **DesRosiers Endowment for the Advancement of Automotive Studies**

Interest from this trust will support an annual award for a student in the Odette School of Business and a student in the Faculty of Engineering. Based on a minimum cumulative average of 83% and demonstrated financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), meeting OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Preference will be given to a student pursuing automotive studies in some capacity at the University of Windsor. Apply on line.

### **Dr. Ming Ouyange Scholarship**

One award of \$1500 are available for 2017/18. Awarded to a full time undergraduate student in Year 3 or Year 4 of the Bachelor of Commerce Program with a concentration in Marketing. Based on academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 70% is required), an interest in pursuing a career in marketing and active membership in the Odette Marketing Association/Society (OMA). Applicants must submit a 500 word summary outlining your interest in the marketing profession, your involvement including in the OMA, the community, other on campus activities or professionally that has led to your academic success within the marketing concentration. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status). Apply online.

### **Edward A. Kukiel Scholarship**

Awarded annually to an undergraduate student registered in any year in the Odette School of Business, based on academic achievement (minimum cumulative of 75% required) and proven financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), who meet Ontario residency requirements. If you have applied for a "University of Windsor In course Bursary" by October 15 through the awards search, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **Edward Ducharme Memorial Scholarship in Business**

Awarded annually to a full time undergraduate student in Year 3 in the Odette School of Business. Based on academic standing (minimum 75% cumulative average required), and documented financial need. If you have applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **Edward Zdziarski Award**

Interest from this trust will support an annual award for an undergraduate Business student in Year 2 and beyond with an Accounting concentration. Based on academic merit (minimum cumulative average of 78%) and demonstrated financial need. Apply online.

### **Fleisher Award in Business and Community Leadership**

Interest from this trust will support an annual award to an Odette School of Business student in Year 3 or 4. Based on a minimum cumulative average of 75%, demonstrated financial need, and leadership contributions to the Golden Key International Honour Society, Commerce Society, Business Marketing Society, or the Honourary Accounting Society. Candidates must be an active member or officer of one of these societies. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), meeting OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Apply online.

### **German Canadian Business and Professional Association Bursary**

Awarded to a full time student registered in Year 3 or 4 in Business Administration, Engineering, or Computer Science participating in an academic exchange or co-op work placement in Germany. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), have a minimum cumulative average of 78% and demonstrate financial need. Fall deadline: September 30. Winter deadline: January 30.

### **Gilbert Horne Memorial Scholarship**

One award given annually to a student registered full time in year 2, 3 or 4 in the Odette School of Business. Based on academic achievement (minimum cumulative average of 80% required), and proven financial need. Established in 2001 by Dr. Edward Rosenbaum. If you have applied for this University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **Harry Rosen -- Robert J. Humphrey Scholarship**

Interest from this trust will support an annual award for an undergraduate student in Year 3 or 4 of the Bachelor of Commerce program. Based on academic merit (minimum cumulative and major average of 75%) and proven financial need. To be considered, an applicant should have outstanding leadership and community involvement, be active in promoting the University, participate in campus life, and have made a significant contribution to the University. Apply online.

### **Holland Cleaning Solutions Award**

Awarded to a full time student registered in Year 1 in the Faculty of Business. Based on scholastic merit (minimum cumulative average of 83%). Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), residing in Ontario, with proven financial need. To be considered for this award, you must apply for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15.

### **J.R. Calcott Memorial Fund**

Income from this Fund provides two awards annually; one to a student who has completed Level 3 of the Bachelor of Commerce program, entering Level 4, and one to a student registered in the Master of Business Administration program. Recipients must have demonstrated a strong interest in the area of entrepreneurship either by high school grades in related courses or by serious research and have a minimum cumulative average of 70%. Apply on line. Deadline: October 31.

### **Kate Taylor OAS Scholarship**

Awarded annually to a student who is entering 4th year of the Bachelor of Commerce program, or the Post Graduate Accounting Certificate program, and plans to pursue a CPA designation, with plans to work for an Approved Training Office. The successful candidate must be considered a well-rounded individual who is hardworking and has a determined spirit. Established by family and friends in honour and memory of Kate Taylor.

### **KPMG James S. Clark Memorial Award**

Awarded annually to a third year student in the Bachelor of Commerce Program, who has expressed an interest in becoming a chartered accountant. This student will have exceptional academic credentials, and will have demonstrated through their extra-curricular activities an acumen towards participating in athletics. A minimum cumulative average of 75% is required. Apply on line.

### **Lori Family Scholarship**

Interest from this trust will support an annual award to an undergraduate Varsity Athlete in second year and beyond in any program. Based on academic merit (minimum prior year average of 75%) and demonstrated financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) in Ontario who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship." \*Early Deadline July 15. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (Athletes who have applied before July 15 will receive first consideration).

### **LucasWorks! Entrepreneurship Scholarship**

Awarded annually to a full time female undergraduate student, enrolled in the Odette School of Business, who demonstrates an interest in entrepreneurship by participating in start-up programs in the EPI Centre. Applications are accepted from students in Year 2, 3 and 4 who have a minimum cumulative average of 73% and proven financial need. Candidates must also submit a statement (minimum of 500 words) outlining their interest in entrepreneurship. Apply online.

### **Mary Penfold Award**

Awarded annually to a second, third or fourth year Business or Civil Engineering student. Based on good academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 72%), as well as participation in sports or extracurricular activities. Established in 1997 by Mr. & Mrs. Louis Scodeller in memory of their daughter. Apply on line. Deadline: January 31.

### **Mike Ventrella Memorial Scholarship in Business**

Awarded annually to an undergraduate student registered in second year or beyond in the Odette School of Business whose concentration is Accounting or Finance. Based on academic merit (minimum cumulative average of 78% required) and demonstrated financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) in Ontario who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line.

### **Nelson Soulliere Scholarship in Business Administration**

Awarded annually to an outstanding student in either Year 3 or Year 4 of the Bachelor of Commerce program. Based on academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 76%) and an applicant's overall University and/or community involvement. Established in 1995 by Merchant's Paper Company, Windsor, Ltd., in recognition of Mr. Nelson Soulliere's retirement after fifty three years of service to the company and his community. Apply on line.

### **Odette Family Entrance Award in Business Administration**

Several entrance scholarships will be awarded annually to Canadian and Permanent Resident students residing in Ontario, who are entering directly from an Ontario High School, to the Business Administration program. Based on scholastic merit (minimum scholarship average of 80%), citizenship (must be Canadian citizen or permanent resident residing in Ontario), with demonstrated financial need. Recipients may not simultaneously hold another major scholarship. These awards have been established through donations from Louis L. Odette and Edmund Odette through the OSOTF initiative. To be considered for this award, you must apply for "Awards for Entering Students with Financial Need" or by applying for the "University of Windsor In Course Bursary".

### **Odette School of Business Gold Brick Fund**

Two awards for students registered in Level 2 or 3 of the Bachelor of Commerce program. Awarded on the basis of combined academic excellence and extracurricular achievement. Submit letter of application and resume to [odettesuccess@uwindsor.ca](mailto:odettesuccess@uwindsor.ca) Deadline: September 30.

### **Odette/OAVR Award for Leadership**

Awarded annually to an undergraduate student entering year four in the Odette School of Business who is majoring in Marketing. To qualify, applicants must have completed a minimum of five marketing courses, having an overall average of 75% in these courses, a minimum cumulative average of 75%, and must have demonstrated leadership ability. Apply on line.

### **Phillips Hager & North Scholarship**

Awarded annually to a full time student registered in first year of the Business Administration program. The eligible candidate must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (includes those with Protected Persons status), meeting Ontario residency requirements, and having proven financial need. If you have applied for a "University of Windsor In course Bursary" by October 15 through the awards search, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **Professor J. Maxwell Brownlie Excellence in Finance Award**

Interest from this trust will support two awards annually to students in Year 4 in the Finance program with demonstrated knowledge and experience with Windsor/Essex business and enterprise. The awards will be granted to one female student and to one male student, each with a minimum cumulative average of 83%. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status). The Professor J. Maxwell Brownlie Excellence in Finance Award is a lasting memorial to Professor Brownlie's 33 years of service to the Odette School of Business. Apply on line.

### **Richard and Tom Peddie Scholarship**

Awarded to a 3rd or 4th year student registered full time in the Bachelor of Commerce Program at the Odette School of Business. The applicants will be well rounded students, competing based on academics, athletics, volunteer work, student government, campus clubs and other relevant extracurricular activities. A minimum cumulative average of 73% is required. Apply on line. Deadline: October 31.

### **Richard Peddie Leadership Award**

Awarded annually to a full time undergraduate Business student in Year 3 or 4 whose impact as a leader on the life and success of the Odette School of Business has been substantial and has occurred over a period of time (rather than only as a result of a single initiative no matter how significant that one time event). Applicants are required to submit a CV along with a one page (500 word) statement outlining the characteristics and activities which qualify them for this award. Also based on academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 73% required). A formal presentation will be made to the recipient of this award at the annual Odette gala in March. Apply on line.

### **Robert E. Krivoshein Entrance Bursary in Business Administration**

Three awards available. Renewable for three additional years. Awarded to Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), residing in Ontario and entering Year 1 in the Odette School of Business, on the basis of scholastic merit (renewal requires a minimum cumulative average of 72%) and financial need. Established in 1983 by Robert E. Krivoshein, member of the Commerce Class of 1969. Applications open up every four years. Apply on line. Deadline: June 1. Awards next available 2019/2020.

### **Robert J. Humphrey Award sponsored by Harry Rosen Inc. & Friends and the University of Windsor Alumni (Toronto Chapter)**

Annual awards designated for undergraduate, full time students enrolled in the Bachelor of Commerce program who will be entering 3rd or 4th year and who have a minimum cumulative and major average of 75%. Not only do these candidates excel academically, but they also have outstanding records of leadership and community involvement, are active in promoting the University, participate in campus life, and have made a significant contribution to the University. Financial need may also be a consideration. Sponsored by Harry Rosen Inc. & Friends and the University of Windsor Alumni (Toronto Chapter). Apply on line.

### **Robert J. Lavigne Memorial Scholarship**

One award will be given annually to a student taking courses in Transportation Logistics, Internal Logistics (Operations Management) and/or Supply Chain. Based on academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 75% required) and demonstrated financial need. Established in memory of Robert J. Lavigne, former traffic manager at Hiram Walker, an individual who was passionate about logistics and transportation and a staunch supporter of local shippers. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), meeting OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line.

### **Robert Sellars Bursary in Business**

Interest from this trust will support one award annually (up to \$2500) to an undergraduate student registered in second year or beyond in the Odette School of Business. Based on academic merit (minimum cumulative average of 72% required) and demonstrated financial need. This award is sponsored by Robert Sellars, MBA, class of 1986. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) in Ontario who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. If you have applied for a "University of Windsor In course Bursary" by October 15 through the awards search, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **Sandra Berlasty Award for International Exchange Students**

Awarded annually to Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) enrolled full time in the Odette School of Business in the year of studies appropriate to the exchange being applied for. Recipients must be in good academic standing and are expected to return to the University of Windsor upon completion of the exchange program. Apply on line. Deadline: October 15.

### **Sandy Berlasty Scholarship in Finance**

Awarded to a full time Business student in third year, going into fourth. Candidate must have successfully completed half (4) of the required courses by their third year of study towards obtaining a concentration in finance. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative average of 75%, must be a Canadian citizen, a Permanent Resident, or Protected Person in Ontario who meets Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements, and can demonstrate financial need. Apply on line.

### **The Centre for Learning in Retirement (a project of Uni Com) Award**

One or more awards will encourage improvement and excellence in a Faculty of Business student studying in Year 2, 3 or 4. Based on academic achievement (a minimum cumulative average of 75% required). Candidates must be must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), residing in Ontario with demonstrated financial need. If you have applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **The Michael Nudelman Leadership Award**

Interest from trust will provide one scholarship annually to a 2nd or 3rd year student registered full time in the BCOMM (Honours Business Administration) program who has taken a leadership interest in sports. A minimum cumulative average of 73% is required. Apply on line.

### **The Robert Little Scholarship**

Up to four scholarships awarded annually to full time undergraduate students registered in any year in the Odette School of Business. Based on academic merit (minimum cumulative average of 70%) and proven financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status). If you have applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search you will automatically be considered. Past recipients may be given consideration but must apply for the In Course Bursary in subsequent years.

### **The Rolf Falkenberg Award in Business**

Awarded annually to an undergraduate student in Year 2 or 3 in the Odette School of Business. Based on academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 75%), demonstrated community involvement, and financial need. Preference may be given to a student who is involved in sports either as a participant, coach or mentor. Apply online.

### **Union Gas Award of Excellence in Accounting**

Value: \$1,000. Awarded annually to a student registered in Year 3 or Year 4 Business Administration (not co-op) who: is considering a career of chartered accountancy; achieves superior academic results; and, who demonstrates Union Gas corporate values of stewardship, integrity, respect for the individual, safety, and initiative. ### **Wai P. Lam Bursary**

### **Windsor Family Credit Union Business Administration Co-operative Education Scholarship**

Awarded to a Year 4 student registered full time in the Honours Business Administration Co-operative Education program, based on academic achievement (minimum cumulative average of 78%), proven financial need and citizenship. Candidate must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (includes those with Protected Persons status), meeting OSAP Ontario residency requirements. If you have applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **Yves Landry Scholarship in Business Administration**

An annual award to a Year 2, 3, or 4 student in Business Administration. Applicants must have maintained academic excellence (minimum cumulative average of 80%) and have demonstrated an involvement in community and volunteer activities. Apply on line. Deadline: October 31.
