AWARDS FOR NURSING STUDENTS - 2017/18

Canadian Nursing Students' Award

One award valued at \$100 to a student registered full time in any year of the B.Sc.N. program (Plan I or II). Applicants must have completed at least one term of full time study in Nursing at the University of Windsor, with a cumulative average of 72%, and must demonstrate their involvement in promoting the image of CNSA and Nursing via campus, community or clinical activity. Applicants must submit a letter of reference from a professional in the field. For further information please contact the Faculty of Nursing. Application form available on Nursing website.

Charles and Ethel Cohen Family Foundation Nursing Scholarship

One scholarship will be given to a student entering their 3rd year of the Nursing program and has a minimum cumulative average of 78% at the end of their second year. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), as well as a resident of Windsor/Essex County. Applicants must submit a one paragraph statement describing how he/she will use their Nursing degree to give back to the Windsor/Essex County community. Apply on line.

CIDA Bursary: Windsor/Jordan Nursing Initiative

One award granted to an undergraduate Nursing student who is in good academic standing (must have completed at least one year of program) and demonstrates financial need. If you have applied for the "University of Windsor In Course Bursary" by October 15 on this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.

Clinical Excellence Award

Awarded annually to a year one student who has completed the first year of the Collaborative Baccalaureate Nursing Program (cumulative average 75% required) and achieved excellence in level one clinical courses. The successful candidate has also demonstrated:

- exceptional critical thinking in all aspects of the clinical program
- proficient physical assessment skills
- outstanding communication skills, and
- emerging leadership abilities

Along with the on line application, candidates must present a letter of recommendation from his/her clinical instructor to the Student Awards Office, which is appropriately identified for this award. Apply on line.

Doreen Hughson Beatty Scholarship in Nursing

Awarded to students registered full time in Year 2, 3 or 4 in the Faculty of Nursing, based on good academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 73% required) and proven financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with

Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. If you have applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 on this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.

Dr. Donna M. Foley Scholarship

Awarded to a full time Collaborative Nursing Student in Year 3 or 4, or to a Graduate Nursing student, based on scholarly activity relating to one or a combination of the following areas: Spirituality in Nursing, Ethics, Research or Palliative Care. Also based on academic excellence with a minimum 75% average required in all nursing courses. Candidates must submit a one page essay on one of the four areas outlined above, detailing how this scholarship would further assist them in their scholarly pursuits. If no full time students are eligible, part time students may be considered. Apply on line.

Dr. John Kidd Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a full time undergraduate student in the Faculty of Science, Faculty of Nursing, or Faculty of Human Kinetics, on the basis of academic achievement (minimum cumulative average of 78% required). The eligible candidate must demonstrate part time employment of 10 or more hours per week, must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (includes those with Protected Persons status), who meets Ontario residency requirements, and demonstrates financial need. The Dr. John Kidd Memorial Scholarship has been established to honour the memory of Dr. Kidd who was Medical Director of the University of Windsor's Student Health Services from 1992 until 2004. Apply on line.

Elizabeth H. Gillespie Memorial Scholarships

Four awards will be granted annually to third year undergraduate students in Nursing who have a specialized interest in community health nursing, advanced nursing practice and/or in the role of nurse practitioners in Canada. A minimum 75% cumulative average is required. Applicants must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) residing in Ontario who have demonstrated financial need. Graduate students in the Nursing program who meet the above requirements will also be considered. Apply on line.

Ethel Knister Memorial Grant

Available to a student from Windsor or Essex County enrolled in any year beyond the first, in the University of Windsor Faculty of Nursing. Award granted on the basis of scholastic achievement and financial need. If you applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.

Giuseppe Slongo Scholarship

Interest from this trust will support one award to a full time, second year Nursing student. Based on a minimum cumulative average of 83% and financial need. The eligible candidate must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meets Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency. If you have applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.

Glenda Ristimaki Memorial Bursary

Awarded annually to a full time student registered in Year 3 or 4 of the Collaborative BScN program or in Year 1 or 2 of the Post RN BScN program on the basis of financial need and academic standing (a minimum cumulative average of 72% is required). If no full time students are eligible, part time students may be considered. If you have applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.

India Canada Association Scholarship

Interest from this trust will support an annual award for a full time, second year student. Based on financial need and a minimum cumulative average of 78% (for students in Engineering, Nursing, and Science) or 80% for students in all other faculties. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Preference will be given to students who have shown involvement in activities associated with Indian culture. Apply on line.

Isabel and David Wilson Nursing Scholarships Endowment

Awarded to two students registered full time in the Faculty of Nursing who will be entering Year 3 or Year 4 in the upcoming Fall semester. Based on good academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 75%), and proven financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Together with the Marilyn and Sandy Wilson Nursing Scholarship Endowment, these scholarships salute from both perspectives the importance of the nurse patient relationship. **Candidates must provide a brief written statement demonstrating an appreciation of the importance of the nurse patient relationship. By submitting this statement, applicants agree that a copy of their statement may be released to the donor, should they be selected as the scholarship recipient. Recipients cannot hold both the Marilyn and Sandy Wilson Nursing Scholarship and the Isabel and David Wilson Nursing Scholarship concurrently. Apply on line.

Isidoro and Maria Marcocchio Family Memorial Bursary

Up to three bursaries awarded annually to students registered in Year 2 or beyond of the Plan I Bachelor of Science in Nursing program on the basis of financial need and academic standing. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who reside in Ontario. Established in 1991 by the family and friends of Isidoro and Maria Marcocchio. If you have applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.

Janet Davidson Scholarship in Nursing

The income from this fund will be used to provide support to one or more qualified undergraduate students registered full time in the Faculty of Nursing. Eligible candidates must have a good academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 72%), and must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) residing in Ontario who demonstrate financial need. If you have applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.

Jennifer Gignac Memorial Award

The interest from this endowed trust is to be awarded annually to a fourth year Nursing student who has made a significant contribution to campus and community life. Karrie Beecroft Memorial Scholarship

Awarded to a full time, second year Nursing student, based on good academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 75% required) and proven financial need. The eligible candidate must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meets Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency. If you have applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.

Kay Moderwell Community Nursing Award

Awarded to a full time fourth year student completing the final year of the Bachelor of Science in Nursing program. Candidates must demonstrate a strong dedication to excellence in nursing, with a special commitment to and high academic achievement in Community Health (home) Nursing in Canada. Apply online. Deadline: January 31.

Labour Sponsored Gary L. Parent Community and Health Services Scholarship

Interest from this trust will support three annual awards to fourth year students in the Faculties of Human Kinetics, Nursing, and Science. Based on good academic standing and financial need. Applicants must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. To be considered for this award you must apply for the "University of Windsor In Course Bursary" by October 15

Lori Dupont Scholarship

Interest from this trust will support an annual award for an undergraduate student registered full time in any year in the Faculty of Nursing. Based on good academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 75%), demonstrated leadership qualities, compassion and empathy, and proven financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line.

Marian (Lockwood) Wright Nursing Scholarship

Interest from this trust will support an annual award for a Nursing student in Year 2, 3 or 4. Based on academic achievement (minimum cumulative average of 75% required) and financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Preference will be given to a student who supports their community through volunteering. Applicants are required to submit a short statement outlining their community involvement and/or volunteer experience. Apply on line.

Marilyn and Sandy Wilson Nursing Scholarships Endowment

Awarded to two students registered full time in the Faculty of Nursing who will be entering Year 3 or Year 4 in the upcoming Fall semester. Based on good academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 75%) and proven financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. One award granted annually to a full time undergraduate student entering Year 2 of the Nursing program with a minimum cumulative average of 75%. Interested candidates must submit a short statement outlining their motivation and commitment to pursue a career in palliative care nursing. Apply online.

Nursing Society Student Excellence Award

Awarded annually to a full time undergraduate Nursing student (registered in any year) based on good academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 73% required). Candidates must also demonstrate excellence in extracurricular activities and leadership ability for the benefit of students at the University of Windsor. Apply on line.

Pan Wai Yiu Family Scholarship

Two awards available. Awarded to a Year 3 or 4 BSc Nursing student (full or part time). Based on excellent academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 85% required). Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet Ontario residency requirements and demonstrate financial need. Applicants must provide a statement of recommendation from their community clinical instructor. Applicants must also submit a short synopsis to describe their clinical excellence in relation to the standards of Canadian community health nursing practice. Apply on line.

Suzanne Parnell Memorial Bursary

Awarded annually to a full time undergraduate Nursing student in Year 3 or 4 with a strong interest in Public/Community Nursing. Based on good academic standing and financial need. Suzanne Parnell was a dedicated Public Health Nurse, providing over 30 years of nursing to the community through the Windsor Essex County Health Unit. It is through this memorial bursary that the Parnell family will continue Suzanne's desire to assist others, to the benefit of

candidates whose interest lies in the Public/Community Nursing field. If you have applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.

University of Windsor Women's Auxiliary Bursary in Nursing

Awarded annually to a student in Year 2 Nursing or beyond, on the basis of scholastic standing and financial need. If you have applied for the University of Windsor In Course Bursary by October 15 through this awards search you will automatically be considered for this award.
