



AWARDS FOR STUDENTS IN AN EXCHANGE PROGRAM - 2017/18

Anita W. and Arthur Wendt Award in German

Awarded to a German Major student returning for Year 3 or 4, with the highest major average in German program courses (minimum 3 German language program courses) who demonstrates financial need. Preference given to a student registered in the Ontario Baden Wurtemberg Exchange Program. Successful candidate must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (includes those with Protected Persons status), who meets Ontario residency requirements. Established in 2003 in honour of Anita W. and Arthur Wendt by Susan Wendt Hildebrandt. Apply on line.

International Co-op Placement Bursary

The Centre for Career Education provides one bursary per term of up to \$750 for students who do not qualify for the International Travel Bursary. Candidates must have been accepted to an international placement for their co-op term. Criteria for consideration will include demonstration of financial need. Recipients may re apply, although preference will be given to students who have not previously qualified. Apply on line. Deadline: October 31 for fall term; February 15 for winter; June 15 for Summer.

International Travel Bursary

Awards of up to \$750 per term are available to students who take a full course load through a University of Windsor Exchange Program, or who will be working abroad for a limited income through a Co-op placement. Recipients will be those who have not already received support toward meeting travel costs through other channels. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents and residents of Ontario, have completed at least three courses at the University of Windsor and must demonstrate financial need. Applications should be submitted on line as early as possible, but no later than Sept. 15 for fall or fall/winter study periods; January 15 for winter term only; May 15 for summer only.

International Travel Bursary for Visa Students

Awards are available to full time international students (not for Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents) selected to travel on a University of Windsor sponsored International Exchange Program, or international co-op placement. Students must be enrolled in a degree program in year three or above, and demonstrate financial need. Applications should be submitted as early as possible. Apply on line.

La Bourse des Anciens du Departement de Francais

One bursary is available annually. Awarded based on financial need and academic performance, to a student taking part in the Third Year Abroad program at the University of Nice. Apply to the French Department.

Martha & Werner Hildebrandt Award

Awarded to a Year 2, 3 or 4 full time Communication Studies student. Preference will be given to a Communication Studies student going on an exchange. Based on good academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 72%), and proven financial need. The successful candidate must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (includes those with Protected Persons status), who meets Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line.

Mrs. Whissle French Scholarship

Awards will be allocated annually to full time students in the French program participating in exchange programs. The awards are based on good academic standing (minimum major average of 75%) and financial need. Successful candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), meeting OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line. Fall deadline: July 15; Winter deadline: November 15.

Professor Adolf Ehrentraut Exchange Program in Sociology

One award annually to a Year 3 or 4 Sociology student participating in an Exchange Program. Candidates must have good academic standing and demonstrate financial need. Established in 1998 by Margaret Ehrentraut in memory of her husband, Professor Adolf Ehrentraut. Apply on line.

Sandra Berlasty Award for International Exchange Students

Awarded annually to Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) enrolled full time in the Odette School of Business in the year of studies appropriate to the exchange being applied for. Recipients must be in good academic standing and are expected to return to the University of Windsor upon completion of the exchange program. Apply on line. Deadline: October 15.

University of Windsor Exchange Scholarship

Initial donation of \$3000 in 2007 through University Development to establish fund. For undergraduate students studying through a U of W Exchange. Selection through recommendation of Student Exchange Office.
