## **AWARDS FOR STUDENTS IN HUMAN KINETICS 2017/18**

### **Dr. John Kidd Memorial Scholarship**

Awarded to a full time undergraduate student in the Faculty of Science, Faculty of Nursing, or Faculty of Human Kinetics, on the basis of academic achievement (minimum cumulative average of 78% required). The eligible candidate must demonstrate part time employment of 10 or more hours per week, must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (includes those with Protected Persons status), who meets Ontario residency requirements, and demonstrates financial need. The Dr. John Kidd Memorial Scholarship has been established to honour the memory of Dr. Kidd who was Medical Director of the University of Windsor's Student Health Services from 1992 until 2004. Apply on line.

### **Dr. Richard Moriarty Award**

Two awards available to students registered in the third or fourth year of Kinesiology. A minimum cumulative average of 75% and contributions to campus life beyond the classroom are prerequisites to be considered for this award. Financial need will be considered. Applicants must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), residing in Ontario. Established in 1998 in honour of Dr. Richard Moriarty and his years of contributions to the Faculty of Human Kinetics and supported annually by the Human Kinetics alumni. Apply on line.

### **Evelyn Manera Memorial Award**

Awarded to a Year 2 or 3 female Kinesiology student based on good academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 73%) and demonstrated extracurricular volunteer activity. Apply on line.

### **Faculty of Human Kinetics Founders' Scholarships**

One award each to a male and a female student in his/her second year of full time study in the Department of Kinesiology. Based on academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 78% required), and financial need. Co-curricular excellence and volunteer service will be a consideration. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), residing in Ontario. This scholarship was established to honour the Founders of the Faculty of Human Kinetics. Apply on line.

### **Human Kinetics Publishers Award**

Awarded annually to a Kinesiology student who has shown strong leadership capabilities and has a minimum cumulative average of 73%. Preference will be given to a student who is a current member of a Lancer Athletic Team. This award was established in 2005 to honour the founder of Human Kinetics Publishers (HKP), Rainer Martens, PhD, by Human Kinetics Canada. Apply on line.

### **Kit Man Siew Bursary**

Awarded annually to a student in Human Kinetics who requires financial assistance. Established in 1995. If you have applied for a "University of Windsor In course Bursary" through this awards search by October 15, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **Labour Sponsored Gary L. Parent Community and Health Services Scholarship**

Interest from this trust will support three annual awards to fourth year students in the Faculties of Human Kinetics, Nursing, and Science. Based on good academic standing and financial need. Applicants must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. To be considered for this award you must apply for the "University of Windsor In Course Bursary" by October 15

### **Michael W. Ayris Millennium Scholarship**

An annual award for Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) residing in Ontario in Level 3 or 4 of the Human Kinetics program. Students must have minimum cumulative average of 76%, demonstrate financial need and have extensive co-curricular involvement in Human Kinetics. Established in 1999 in memory of Michael W. Ayris. Apply on line.

### **P.J. Galasso Joy of Effort Award**

Interest from this trust will support an annual award for a full time undergraduate Kinesiology student in Year 4 who has a record of leadership, involvement in extracurricular activities, participates in campus life and has made a contribution to the Faculty of Human Kinetics. Based on academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 75% required) and financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) in Ontario who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line.

### **Ralt Wade Memorial Award**

Awarded annually to a student/athlete (preferably Men's Basketball) enrolled in the Faculty of Human Kinetics. Must demonstrate academic excellence, strong leadership, community service and good citizenship and financial need. Candidates must be Canadian citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) residing in Ontario. Available to undergraduate students who have completed at least one year of full time study in the Faculty of Human Kinetics and have a minimum cumulative average of 72%. Apply on line.

### **Robert Sellars Bursary in Kinesiology**

Interest from this trust will support one award annually (up to \$2500) to an undergraduate Kinesiology student registered in second year or beyond. Based on academic merit (minimum cumulative average of 72% required) and demonstrated financial need. Sponsored by Robert Sellars, Bachelor of Human Kinetics graduate, class of 1980. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) in Ontario who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line..

### **William Bond Award**
