## **AWARDS FOR STUDENTS IN THE FACULTY OF SCIENCE 2017/18**

### **Alexander, Felixa and Dr. Walter Kindiak Fund**

Awarded to a full time third or fourth year student in the Faculty of Science who is applying to medical school. Based on excellent academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 83% required). Preference may be given to a student with interest in Ukrainian culture and tradition. Students who are active members of the Pre Med Club are encouraged to apply. Apply on line.

### **Alfred Russell Wallace Exploration Fellowship**

Two awards granted to a full time, 3rd or 4th year student enrolled in a Biological Science program that is pursuing a research or experiential learning opportunity in organismal biology, with preference going to those conducting the research outside the local area. The successful applicant will be selected in a competition established and conducted by a committee under the supervision of the Head of the Department of Biological Sciences. The successful applicant must be a current Biological Science student and student must remain in good standing. Applicants must include a short (two paragraph) description of the research/learning opportunity and how the opportunity will further their career interests.

### **Cecile (Robinet) & Lionel Lacoursiere Scholarship**

Value: up to \$2500. Awarded to a full time, undergraduate student registered in Biology or Arts & Social Science (excluding Visual Arts, Drama & Music), based on good academic standing (minimum 75% cumulative average) and demonstrated financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Person status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. If you have applied for a "University of Windsor In course Bursary" by October 15 through this awards search, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **David Cornhill Alta Gas Scholarship**

Awarded to a full time student in either the Faculty of Business, Engineering or Science, who has demonstrated financial need. A minimum cumulative average of 83% is required. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), residing in Ontario. Preference will be given to a student from the Chatham/Kent area. Apply on line.

### **Doctor Family Health Research Student Support Award**

One award granted annually to a full time undergraduate or graduate student in Biological Sciences who is involved in or conducting clinical health research. Based on academic standing (minimum 85% cumulative average required) and financial need. Candidates must be a Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), meeting OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line.

### **Doreen Hughson Beatty Scholarship in Biology**

Awarded to students registered full time in Year 3 or 4 in the Department of Biology, based on excellent academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 80% required), and proven financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. If you have applied for the "University of Windsor In Course Bursary" by October 15 through this awards search, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **Dr. David H. Hubel Scholarship**

Awarded annually to a first year student registered full time in the Faculty of Science or Social Science, on the basis of scholastic standing (minimum cumulative average of 80%) and financial need. Applicants are required to submit a brief outline of "Ideas for the Science Society" (see details in on line application). Candidates must meet OSOTF requirements Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), residing in Ontario. Established in 2004 by the Science Society, in honour of Nobel Laureate Dr. David H. Hubel. Apply on line.

### **Dr. John Kidd Memorial Scholarship**

Awarded to a full time undergraduate student in the Faculty of Science, Faculty of Nursing, or Faculty of Human Kinetics, on the basis of academic achievement (minimum cumulative average of 78% required). The eligible candidate must demonstrate part time employment of 10 or more hours per week, must be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident (includes those with Protected Persons status), who meets Ontario residency requirements, and demonstrates financial need. The Dr. John Kidd Memorial Scholarship has been established to honour the memory of Dr. Kidd who was Medical Director of the University of Windsor's Student Health Services from 1992 until 2004. Apply on line.

### **Dr. Michael & Ann Kane Science Scholarship**

One award granted annually to a full time undergraduate student in Year 4 in Chemistry/Biochemistry or Biology. Based on academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 85% required). Financial need may be a consideration. The scholarship will alternate between the two programs, awarded to Chemistry/Biochemistry in even numbered years and to Biology in odd numbered years. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status). Apply online. Deadline: January 15.

### **Drs. Roger and Audrey Thibert Award for Clinical Research**

Awarded annually to a student enrolled full time in Year 4 or in Graduate Studies in the Faculty of Science, doing clinical research. Based on excellent academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 80%) and proven financial. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line. Deadline: February 15.

### **Father Faught Memorial Bursary**

One or more awards to deserving Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) in the field of Mathematics, assigned on the basis of financial need and academic merit. Established in 1975 by Friends in memory of Father Donald Faught,

long-time Head of the Mathematics Department. If you have applied for the "University of Windsor In Course Bursary" by October 15 through this awards search, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **Freed Orman Foundation Scholarships**

Three awards available to students registered full time in Year 3 or 4 of the Faculty of Science, in Biochemistry, Chemistry, or Biology, or a similar program. Preference will be given to students who are applying to medical school. Based on excellent academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 86% required). Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP residency requirements and demonstrate financial need. Apply on line.

### **Homer Plante Clifford Peters Roy Lacoursiere Scholarship**

Value: up to \$2500. Awarded to a full time, undergraduate student registered in Biology or Arts & Social Science (excluding Visual Arts, Drama & Music). Based on good academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 75% required) and demonstrated financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. If you have applied for a "University of Windsor In course Bursary" by October 15 through the awards search, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **India Canada Association Scholarship**

Interest from this trust will support an annual award for a full time, second year student. Based on financial need and a minimum cumulative average of 78% (for students in Engineering, Nursing, and Science) or 80% for students in all other faculties. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Preference will be given to students who have shown involvement in activities associated with Indian culture. Apply on line.

### **IT Services Scholarship in Computer Science**

Interest from this trust will support one or more awards for undergraduate students registered in second year or beyond in the School of Computer Science. Based on academic achievement (minimum cumulative average of 72% required) and financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) in Ontario who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. If you have applied for a "University of Windsor In course Bursary" by October 15 through the awards search, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **Kenneth and Rose Van Meer Memorial Entrance Scholarship**

This award is available to a gay male student registered full time in Year 1 of the Honours Computer Science, Honours Communication Studies, or a Faculty of Science Honours program, with preference given to a Computer Science student. Based on good academic performance (minimum 80% cumulative average required) and demonstrated financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Preference will be given to a resident of Windsor or Essex County who has graduated from a Windsor or Essex County secondary

school. Award is renewable in subsequent years, provided qualifying conditions are maintained. Apply online.

### **Kenneth J. Van Meer Scholarship**

This award is available to gay male students registered full time in Year 2, 3, or 4 in the Honours Computer Science, Honours Communication Studies or a Faculty of Science Honours program with preference given to Computer Science students. Based on good academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 76% required) and demonstrated financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), meeting OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Preference will be given to residents of Windsor or Essex County who have graduated from Windsor or Essex County secondary schools. Award is renewable through re application in subsequent years provided qualifying conditions are maintained. Award cannot be held concurrently with the Kenneth and Rose Van Meer Memorial Entrance Scholarship. Apply on line.

### **Labour Sponsored Gary L. Parent Community and Health Services Scholarship**

Interest from this trust will support three annual awards to fourth year students in the Faculties of Human Kinetics, Nursing, and Science. Based on good academic standing and financial need. Applicants must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. To be considered for this award you must apply for the "University of Windsor In Course Bursary" by October 15

### **Mahmoud Chehayber Bursary**

One award granted annually to a full time undergraduate student in the Faculty of Science. Based on good academic standing and financial need. Preference is given to a chemistry student. Candidates must be a Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), meeting OSAP Ontario residency requirements. If you have applied for the "University of Windsor In Course Bursary" through this awards search by October 15, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **Marie Sanderson Award**

The award will be given to a graduating Environmental Science or Environmental Studies student who has studied Physical Geography. Based on academic excellence (minimum cumulative average of 78% required) and financial need. Preference will be given to a student pursuing a career in Teaching. This award was established 2010 in honour of Dr. Marie Sanderson, a faculty member and scientist for twenty three years, in the Geography department. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) in Ontario who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. Apply online.

### **Maurice Daniel Scholarship**

Awarded to a student registered full time in Year 3 or 4 Biochemistry or Chemistry, with preference given to a candidate who is applying to medical school. Based on good academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 83% required) and proven financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet Ontario residency requirements). Apply on line. Deadline: October

### **Peter and Jean Sonnenfeld Award**

Awarded to two full time students in Year 2, 3 or 4 in the Faculty of Science, registered in the Environmental Sciences program or a related field. Based on academic achievement (minimum cumulative average of 76%) and proven financial need. Recipients must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line.

### **Ron & Myriam Kaye Scholarship**

One award granted annually to a full time undergraduate student in any year of study in Chemistry & Biochemistry. Based on financial need and good academic standing. Apply online.

### **Sovran and Zorzitto Scholarship**

One award granted annually to a full time undergraduate student in Year 4 in Chemistry, Biochemistry or Biology. Based on academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 80% required) and financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), meeting OSAP Ontario residency requirements. If you have applied for a "University of Windsor In course Bursary" by the bursary deadline through this awards search, you will automatically be considered for this award.

### **TELUS Scholarship for the Betterment of the Environment**

Awarded annually to a Year 4, full time student registered in the Environmental Studies or Environmental Science program. Based on good academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 76%) and proven financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line.

### **The Science Society Award**

Established by the Science Society, one award will be given annually to a full time, undergraduate student in Year 2, 3 or 4 in any program within the Faculty of Science. Based on academic performance (minimum cumulative average of 75%) and leadership abilities exhibited through extracurricular activities on campus and/or in the community. Apply on line. Deadline: October 31.

### **Tucker Bachelor of Arts and Science Scholarship**

One scholarship will be awarded annually to a full time undergraduate student in the 8th semester of a Bachelor of Arts and Science degree, who is planning on pursuing post graduate studies and has demonstrated volunteer/work experience which has benefited the greater community. Candidates must be a Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status).

### **University of Windsor Undergraduate Environmental Scholarship**

Awarded annually on the basis of merit to a senior undergraduate student in an environmental program at the University of Windsor who intends to pursue further environmental studies. Areas of Study include: Biological Sciences, Chemistry and Biochemistry, Civil and Environmental Engineering, Earth Sciences, Environmental Science, Environmental Studies or

Visual Arts (Green Corridor included). Based on academic achievement (minimum cumulative average of 83%), proven financial need and citizenship. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line.

**Windsor Family Credit Union Environmental Studies Scholarship**

Awarded to a first year student registered full time in the Environmental Studies program, based on academic achievement (minimum cumulative average of 78%), proven financial need and citizenship. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line.

**Windsor Port Authority - Jack Atchison Award**

Awarded annually on the basis of academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 73%) and financial need, to a student registered full time in Year 2, 3 or 4 Environmental Sciences or Civil & Environmental Engineering, with major area of study concentrated in marine environment or Great Lakes issues. Award recipient will be invited by the Windsor Port Authority to the annual marine dinner where a presentation will be made. Award cannot be held concurrently with the other Windsor Port Authority award. Apply on line.

**Windsor Port Authority Award**

Awarded annually to a student registered in the Environmental Sciences or Civil and Environmental Engineering with major area of study concentrated in marine environment or Great Lakes issues. Based on good academic standing (minimum cumulative average of 73% required) and financial need. Award recipient will be invited by the Windsor Port Authority to the annual marine dinner where a presentation will be made. Award cannot be held concurrently with the Windsor Port Authority Jack Atchison Award. Apply on line.
