AWARDS FOR VARSITY ATHLETES - 2017/18

Alumni Association Toronto Chapter - Blue & Gold Awards

Awarded annually to one male and one female student athlete in any year, any program (undergraduate & graduate) with demonstrated financial need. Candidates must be taking at least a 60% course load. Entering students must have a minimum 80% admission average. Returning students must have a minimum previous year average of 70%. Students must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) meeting OSAP residency rules for Ontario. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship." *Early Deadline July 15. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (athletes who have applied by July 15 will receive first consideration)

Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Need

Several awards are available to University of Windsor varsity athletes who demonstrate financial need. Entering students must have 80% or higher admissions average. Returning students must have a minimum 70% previous year average. Apply on line. *Early Deadline: July 15. Fall subsequent Deadline: October 15. Final Deadline: February 15. (athletes who have applied by July 15 will receive first consideration).

Blue and Gold Athletic Scholarship

Up to four awards are available annually to Varsity Athletes in any Faculty or Program with demonstrated financial need. Candidates must be registered in at least 60% of a full course load. Entering students must have a minimum 80% admissions average. Returning students must have a minimum previous year average of 70%. Students must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), satisfying OSAP residency rules. Graduate students are eligible to apply for this award. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship". *Early Deadline July 15. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (athletes who have applied before July 15 will receive first consideration).

C F Greenhouses Award

Awarded annually to an undergraduate student registered full time in Year 2, 3 or 4 in any faculty, based on academic proficiency (minimum previous year cumulative average of 70% required) and demonstrated financial need. Candidates must be current members of the Men's Varsity Hockey Team, and must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), satisfying OSAP residency rules for Ontario. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship." *Early Deadline July 15. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (athletes who have applied before July 15 will receive first consideration).

Charles M. Tolmie Memorial Awards

One or more awards to members of the Lancer Men's Basketball Team who demonstrate academic proficiency and financial need. If there are no qualified members of the Lancer's Men's Basketball Team in a given year, then members of the Lancers Women's Basketball Team will be considered next followed by qualified male or female members of any other Lancers team. A minimum previous year cumulative average of 70% is required. Students must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), satisfying OSAP residency rules. Graduate students are eligible to apply for this award. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship." *Early Deadline July 15. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (athletes who have applied before July 15 will receive first consideration).

Eddie Hogan Memorial Athletic Financial Award

Awarded annually to students registered in any year, any faculty, with preference given to a returning member of the Lancers men's basketball, or women's basketball team, or a member of a Lancers varsity team in a sport leading to a CIS National Championship. Based on good academic standing (minimum previous year cumulative average of 70%) and proven financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), who meet Ontario residency requirements. Mr. Eddie Hogan was a long-time member of the organizing committee for the Annual University of Windsor Invitational High School Basketball Tournament. This award is created in his memory. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship." *Early Deadline July 15. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (athletes who have applied before July 15 will receive first consideration).

Fred Thomas Memorial Award

One or more annual awards to members of the Men's Lancer Basketball team who demonstrate financial need. Applicants must be registered in Year 2 or beyond with a minimum previous year cumulative average of 70%, and be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status), satisfying OSAP residency rules. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship." *Early Deadline July 15. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (athletes who have applied before July 15 will receive first consideration).

Jerry Slavik Athletics Award

Interest from this fund will be awarded to one male and one female Canadian Citizen/Permanent Resident (includes those with Protected Persons status) student meeting OSAP residency rules for Ontario annually. The students must have completed one year at the University of Windsor, have a minimum previous year cumulative average of 70%, demonstrate financial need, and be a current member of the Lancer Track and Field and/or Cross Country Team. Recipients must display qualities of leadership, team loyalty, and fair play. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship." *Early Deadline July 15. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (athletes who have applied before July 15 will receive first consideration).

Karen Harvie Scholarship

Interest from this trust will support an award for a Men's Varsity Volleyball Athlete in any year of study. If there are no eligible Men's Varsity Volleyball Athletes, the scholarship may be awarded to a Female Varsity Volleyball Athlete. Candidates must be taking at least a 60% course load. Entering students must have a minimum 80% entering average and in course students must achieve a minimum previous year cumulative average of 70%. Applicants must demonstrate financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents, who meet OSAP Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship." *Early Deadline July 15. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (athletes who have applied before July 15 will receive first consideration)

Lori Family Scholarship

Interest from this trust will support an annual award to an undergraduate Varsity Athlete in second year and beyond in any program. Based on academic merit (minimum prior year average of 75%) and demonstrated financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) in Ontario who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship." *Early Deadline July 15. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (athletes who have applied before July 15 will receive first consideration).

Men's Alumni Varsity Soccer Scholarship

Awarded annually to a full time undergraduate or graduate Men's Varsity Soccer student based on good academic performance (minimum previous year cumulative average of 70% required) and demonstrated financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) in Ontario who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship." *Early Deadline July 15. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (athletes who have applied before July 15 will receive first consideration).

Michael Lesansky Athletic Scholarship

Established in memory of Michael Lesansky, an avid golfer, basketball, baseball, and football player and all around supporter of student athletes and sports in general. Interest from this trust will support an annual award to an undergraduate Varsity Athlete registered in second year or beyond in any faculty/program. Preference may be given to a student golfer, however it is the donors' wishes that the award be given every year (preferably in the Fall semester) to the best candidate, regardless of sport, as determined by the Athletics Department. Based on good academic standing (minimum previous year cumulative average of 70%) and proven financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) in Ontario who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship." *Early Deadline July. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (athletes who have applied before July will receive first consideration).

Mike Ventrella Memorial Football Scholarship

Awarded annually to an undergraduate student in any year of study playing Varsity Football. Based on academic achievement (first year applicants must have a minimum 80% entering average; returning students must achieve a minimum previous year cumulative average of 70%) and demonstrate financial need. Candidates must be Canadian Citizens or Permanent Residents (includes those with Protected Persons status) in Ontario who meet Ontario Student Assistance Program Ontario residency requirements. Apply on line through "Awards for Varsity Athletes with Financial Hardship." *Early Deadline July 15. Fall subsequent deadline October 15. Final Deadline February 15. (athletes who have applied before July 15 will receive first consideration).
