





DECONTAMINATE AFTER HANDLING BIOLOGICAL MATERIALS

Viruses can live on hard surfaces for up to 2 days, and on hands for up to 5 minutes.
Wash your hands often to keep yourself and others healthy.



Do not use water with hand sanitizer. Do not use paper towels to dry hands.

Note: Wash hands with soap and water if hands are visibly dirty.
Some manufacturers recommend washing hands with
soap and water after 5-10 applications of gel.
