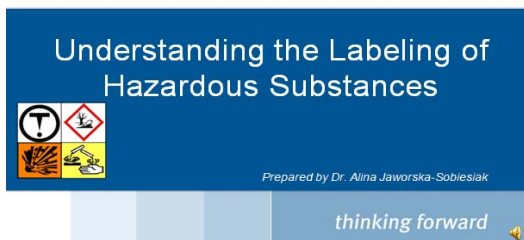
The intention of this course is to offer an overview of various labeling systems as a form of hazard communication and to emphasize the importance of reading and understanding labels before working with chemicals.

What will you learn?

- Why labeling hazardous materials is important.
- The most common labeling systems include:
 1. WHMIS
 2. OSHA, NFPA
 3. European Union, Sigma/Aldrich
 4. GHS
 5. Consumer product labels, and
 6. Pesticides labels
