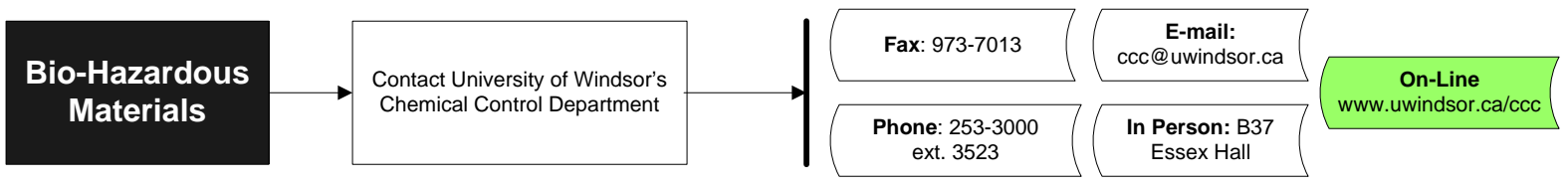
Chemicals are defined as an item which is controlled by a Material Safety Data Sheet or has been assigned a CAS #



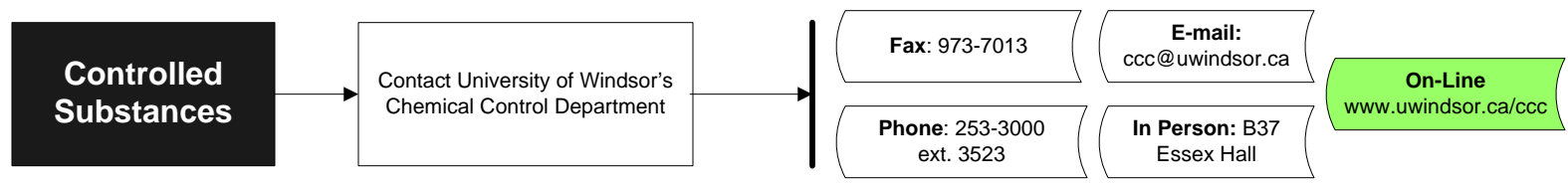
Gas products can be acquired from multiple vendors. The CCC does stock a variety of common gas products. Cylinders/Dewars are delivered to pre-designated locations throughout campus by Facilities Services. For pick-up and/or delivery contact the CCC.



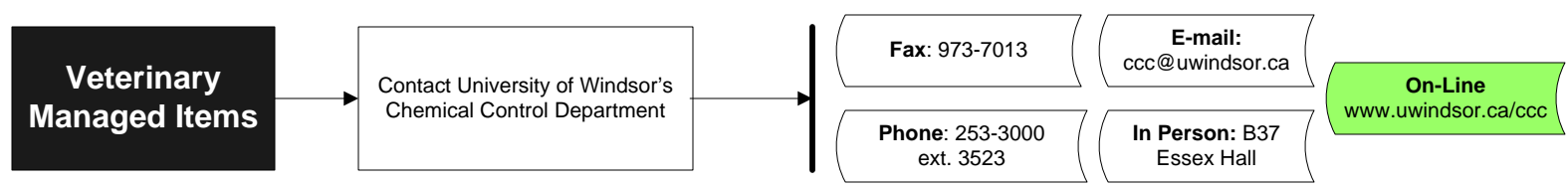
Radioactive materials can only be acquired by individuals who hold a University of Windsor Radioisotope Permit. Please contact the Radiation Safety Officer at ext. 3524 for more information. All orders are subject to verification of regulatory compliance by the RSO.



Biohazardous materials, including cell cultures and all BSL-1 / 2 materials can only be acquired by individuals who hold a University of Windsor Biological Safety Certificate.
