

Communication, Media & Film Degree Requirements

Current Calendar Degree Requirements

General Bachelor of Arts in Communication, Media & Film

Total course equivalents: Thirty

- (a) ten courses, including CMAF-1010, FILM-1100, CMAF-2340, CMAF-2750, plus one of CMAF-2010, CMAF-2250, CMAF-3340 or CMAF-3750, plus five additional CMAF or FILM courses, at least two of which must be at the 3000 level or above (excluding CMAF-3990);
- (b) GART-1500, GART-1510;
- (c) two courses from Arts;
- (d) two courses from Languages or Science;
- (e) two courses from any area of study, excluding Social Sciences;
- (f) six courses from any area of study, including CMAF and FILM;
- (g) six courses from any area of study, excluding CMAF and FILM.

Courses used to calculate the major average are: All courses taken in CMAF and FILM.

Sample Sequencing

Year 1 fall (5 courses): CMAF-1010 (also offered in winter); FILM-1100; GART-1500; 2 non-CMAF/FILM electives to help satisfy Arts, Languages or Science, non-Social Science requirements
PLUS: Education 1199 "Teaching and Learning Part I" (50 hours over two semesters)

Year 1 winter (5 courses): Another 1000- or 2000-level CMAF/FILM course; GART-1510; 3 non-CMAF/FILM electives
PLUS: Education 1199 "Teaching and Learning Part I" (50 hours over two semesters)

Year 2 (10 courses): CMAF-2340; CMAF-2750; 5 courses from any area of study, including CMAF/FILM; 3 non-CMAF/FILM electives
PLUS: Education 2299 "Community Service Education" (50 hours over two semesters)

Year 3: In the third year, students will take the entire Year 1 of the BEd program

Year 4 (10 courses): 1 of CMAF-2010, CMAF-2250, CMAF-3340 or CMAF-3750 (or any other CMAF-, if requirement already satisfied); 4 additional CMAF/FILM courses, with at least 2 at 3000 level or above; 1 course from any area of study, including CMAF/FILM; 4 non-CMAF/FILM electives

Year 5: In the fifth year, students will take the entire Year 2 of the BEd program
