Excellence in Mentoring Award

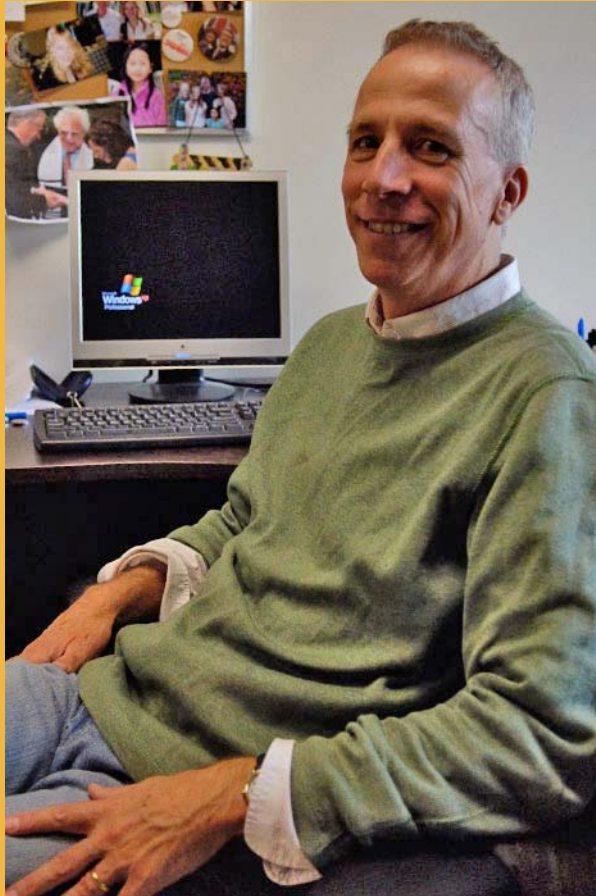
