

PREREQUISITES

Additional Qualification Courses



Education
University of Windsor

Anyone considering taking a Additional Qualification must have an undergraduate degree acceptable to the Ontario College of Teachers (OCT); AND be a member in good standing with the OCT.

SCHEDULE A: ONE SESSION ADDITIONAL BASIC QUALIFICATIONS

Intermediate Basic

(Health & Physical Education, Drama, First Nation, Metis, Inuit, Religious Education in Catholic Schools)

- No university course prerequisites required.

Intermediate Basic

(English, Math*, Science, Geography, History, etc.)

- TWO full university degree credit courses in the subject.
 - *successful completion of Math Proficiency Test in lieu of university courses.
 - *Note: Course weights vary across institutions. Courses weighted as 3 credits are likely to be half courses.

Senior Basic

(any subject)

- FIVE full university degree credit courses in the subject.
- For candidates who already hold a Senior Basic Qualification, a minimum of two full university degree credits in the subject area.
 - *Note: Course weights vary across institutions. Courses weighted as 3 credits are likely to be half courses.

SCHEDULE B: TECHNOLOGICAL EDUCATION

Grade 9/10 level

- Educators with existing technological education qualifications require an entry for the same technological education subject in grade 9 and 10 and in grade 11 and 12.
- Educators without technological education qualifications require FIVE years of work experience, including business or industrial experience, or a combination of postsecondary education and work experience that totals five years.

Grade 11/12 level

- a Certificate of Qualification and Registration with Technological Education Qualifications
- 12 months' work experience, including business or industrial experience, in which you used skills and knowledge related to the subject OR
- post-secondary education equivalent to 12 months' work experience, including business or industrial experience, in which you used skills and knowledge related to the subject OR
- a combination thereof.

SCHEDULE C: ONE SESSION ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATION

Any Subject

- You must hold a Basic Qualification in the respective Primary or Junior or Intermediate or Senior divisions in general studies.

SCHEDULE D: THREE SESSION ADDITIONAL QUALIFICATIONS

Part 1

- You must hold a Basic Qualification in the respective Primary or Junior or Intermediate or Senior divisions in general studies.

Part 2

- Part 1 completed.
- Minimum ONE year of certified teaching experience by the first day of the course, subsequent to certification. One year is equal to 196 days.

Part 3

- Part 2 completed.
- Minimum TWO years certified teaching experience by the first day of the course, subsequent to certification including ONE year in the specialized subject area.

SCHEDULE E: ONE SESSION HONOUR SPECIALIST QUALIFICATIONS

Honour Specialist (any subject)

- FOUR-year (20 full courses) academic undergraduate degree equivalent to 120 credits, (excluding education courses); NINE full courses (non-education) in the subject of the Honour Specialist, with a minimum B average.
- Minimum TWO years certified teaching experience by the first day of the course, subsequent to certification including at least ONE year in the specialized subject area.
