## Qualifications

Instructors selected for this program will be expected to demonstrate:

- International Educator Certification for IB in Teaching and Learning and the IB Advanced Certificate in Teaching and Learning Research.
- Registration with the International Baccalaureate Organization (IBO)
- Certification in one of the IB's four programmes (Primary Years Programme,
  - Middle Years Programme, Diploma Programme, Career-related Programme) and specialization in one or all of the following areas of inquiry:
    - curriculum processes
    - teaching and learning
    - assessment and learning
    - professional learning
- Five years of teaching experience and a deep understanding of an IB programme through teaching the programme for a number of years.

- Appropriate educational qualifications as normally evidenced by a relevant Ph.D., Master's Degree and/or equivalent professional qualifications where appropriate.
- Except in exceptional circumstances, applicants should possess a proven track record of excellence in teaching within an established professional development program. This would be evidenced by one or more of the following:
  - 1) Course evaluations from credit and non-credit courses
  - 2) Qualitative student assessments
  - 3) Client testimonials
- Appropriate subject matter knowledge/expertise. This could be evidenced by one or more of:
  - 1) Publications (refereed articles, textbooks, articles in professional journals, etc.)
  - 2) work experience
  - 3) consulting experiences
- A history of working in a team-oriented/collaborative instructional environment is preferred.
- An expressed willingness to utilize non-traditional methods for student assessments.
- Experience with instructing using the Brightspace Learning Management System or similar system.

Interested applicants must provide:

- 1. A cover letter or statement of interest in teaching that specifies the particular course or courses (indicate course title) the applicant wishes to be considered for. This statement should detail how the applicant meets the stated qualifications.
- 2. A copy of their CV. Note: Instructors who have previously taught the course for which they are applying must include their most recent update CV.
- 3. IEC for IB Certification documents.
- 4. Prior qualitative student assessments and/or client testimonials are particularly welcomed.
