

## Dr. Anthony N. Ezeife



### Mathematics and Indigenous Education (MIE) Award

**Value:** \$1000

**Background:** This annual award was established in 2020 to honour the career of Dr. Anthony N. Ezeife. It recognizes annually a high achieving student in the Faculty of Education who has excelled in mathematics and Indigenous education courses. Dr. Ezeife was a Professor of Mathematics, Statistics, Science, and Indigenous Education in the Faculty of Education from September 1, 2001 to July 1, 2017. Furthermore, all through his distinguished service at the University of Windsor, Dr. Ezeife was a strong voice in, and unrelenting advocate for, **EMR** (Equity, and Mutual Respect) in all its ramifications.

**Criteria:** Awarded on the basis of academic performance to a graduating B. Ed. student who has obtained the highest combined average across their B. Ed. Math and Indigenous Education courses as per the requirements of the Faculty of Education; and, who has demonstrated commitment to equity and mutual respect during their two years as a student in the Faculty of Education. A short, written description illustrating examples of commitment to equity and mutual respect in the community while a student at the Faculty of Education must accompany the application.

**Deadline:** Deadline for full application and supporting documentation is January 31 of each academic year.
