In accordance with Article 54 of the WUFA Collective Agreement, we invite applications from qualified individuals for the position of Sessional / Overload Instructor for the following courses. Courses could be scheduled during the day or evening. All courses (with the exception of certain Technological Studies sections) are delivered in-person. Due to the complexity of our scheduling, we cannot accommodate scheduling requests.

Applicants are expected to possess, at minimum, a masters' degree, or equivalent, in the subject area for which they are applying, with preference given to those holding a completed PhD. Preference is also given to those with experience in the K-12 Ontario school system, as well as OCT certification. Related recent professional development and teaching experience is expected.

- *BEd courses run for 9 weeks per term (not counting any University holidays/breaks) to accommodate for student placements*
