As we begin the new academic year, I am pleased to share Mathematics Proficiency Test (MPT) administration details and supports for the 2025–2026 school year.

The scheduled test administration periods for the 2025–2026 school year are as follows:

- **Fall Test Window:** Monday, September 29, to Saturday, November 22, 2025
- **Winter Test Window:** Monday, January 12, to Saturday, March 21, 2026
- **Spring Test Window:** Monday, April 20, to Saturday, June 6, 2026 (tentative)

Mark your calendar: The registration for the fall test window opens on September 8, 2025. The dates, times and format (in-person at an approved test centre or proctored remotely) of available test sessions will be viewable when you book your session through your Test Applicant account.

Each session lasts approximately 45 minutes and is followed by a live Q&A with EQAO staff, giving you an excellent opportunity to ask any questions you have.
