Dear teacher candidates:

The fall test window for the Mathematics Proficiency Test (MPT) closed on November 22, 2025, and 3206 candidates wrote the test.

For candidates who have not yet been successful or did not take the test during this first test window, two additional test windows are available during the 2025–2026 school year:

- **Winter Test Window:** Monday, January 12–Saturday, March 21, 2026. Registration began on January 2, 2026.
- **Spring Test Window:** Monday, April 20–Saturday, June 6, 2026.

When booking your test session through your [Test Applicant account](#), you will be able to view available dates, times and formats—whether in person at an approved test centre or remotely with online proctoring.
