To Presidents/Chairs of all Teacher Candidate Associations

Dear Teacher Candidate Leader:

We have received notification from the Ontario Secondary School Teachers' Federation (OSSTF) that, in addition to sanctions already in place, members of OSSTF in select bargaining units/schools in Ontario will be engaging in a one-day full withdrawal of services on Wednesday, January 8, 2020. The select bargaining units/schools that will be taking this strike action are listed in Appendix A, which accompanies this letter.

OTF Policy 4 on Teacher Education states that:

- 4.1.6 in the event of a full withdrawal of services in a strike situation involving members of the Federation, schools in which those members serve shall not be used for practicum, or for any other placement of student teachers;
- 4.1.7 in the event of a strike situation involving members of the Federation, schools in which those members serve shall not be used for the inservice program leading to additional qualifications; and
- 4.1.8 in the event of a strike situation involving members of the Federation, no OTF Affiliate shall accept teacher candidates re-assigned from the striking Board.

While the above OTF policies pertain only to strikes by teachers (OTF members), and not to strikes by education workers in the listed bargaining units, it is possible that boards will decide to close schools in which education workers are on a full withdrawal of services. The Dean of your Faculty/School of Education will need to check this with the specific boards, should there be teacher candidates who are in practicum placements in those boards.

We have written to the Deans of Education, asking them to ensure that teacher candidates at your institution are informed about the impending strike action by OSSTF members and that they know there will be no practicum on January 8 in secondary schools that are part of the public English-language boards listed in Appendix A. For the Francophone schools listed in Appendix A, your Dean should check with the appropriate boards to ascertain whether the practicum may continue on January 8 in those boards/schools. We would appreciate it if you would also assist in making sure that all teacher candidates at your institution are well apprised of the situation.
