Background: Established by his family in 2019 in memory of Régis Ronald Plante (May 19, 1953 - Aug 27, 2018.). Régis was born and raised in Windsor and was a graduate of the University of Windsor. He taught with the Windsor-Essex Catholic District School Board and retired from St Joseph's High School. Régis was a dedicated and much loved teacher. His students and colleagues appreciated his sense of humour and his deep knowledge of religion and philosophy. Régis valued his French Canadian heritage, and had a special interest in the history and welfare of Indigenous Peoples.

Criteria: Applicants must be Year II, full-time BEd candidates who are Canadian

citizens or landed immigrants. Awarded on the basis of academic performance and financial need. Preference given to candidates: (i) enrolled in the Beginning Times Teaching service learning course, (ii) who identify as Indigenous, and/or (iii) who demonstrate an interest in

working with indigenous school communities.

academic and other accomplishments that reflect the criteria above.
