







GLOBALINK RESEARCH AWARD (GRA)





- Mitacs Globalink is building a living bridge between Canada and its international partners, establishing and reinforcing international links through the two-way mobility of exceptional students, researchers and faculty.
- Mitacs Globalink Research Award: sends Canadian students abroad to work with leading international researchers
 - 3-month research project in China
 - Jointly supervised by a Canadian professor and an international collaborator at an accredited university in China
 - Award: \$6000 research grant for travel costs and accommodations
 - Timeline for application/proposal package will be provided at upcoming workshop
