In accordance with section 54:07 of the current WUFA Collective Agreement, the **Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering** for the **Fall 2026 Semester (September to December)** invites applications from qualified individuals interested in teaching the following course(s), subject to final budgetary approval, course enrollment and appointment of new full-time faculty.

### Applicants should pay special note to the following items:

- All course offerings listed and their scheduling are subject to final budgetary approval, course enrollment, student demand, facility availability, and the appointment of new faculty.
- Only successful applicants will be contacted.
- The default delivery mode for University of Windsor courses is face-to-face (in-person instruction) unless otherwise specified.
- Successful applicants should be prepared to teach at the scheduled times listed. Changing days/times is not possible.
- Applicants who apply to multiple courses should be prepared to teach any or all of the courses applied to if successful. Notwithstanding other conditions, such applicants will be assigned to courses to best serve the faculty and student needs.
- Applicants should note that courses may have both lecture and lab/tutorial components. Applicants should check the online calendar for the latest course configurations and descriptions to familiarize themselves with the course content.

The Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering is seeking applications from candidates, preferably with a Ph.D. degree in **Electrical and Computer Engineering**, or **related fields**. Applicants with a Masters degree in Electrical and Computer Engineering, or related fields, along with relevant teaching, research, and/or industrial experience applicable to the position listed may be considered. A Professional Engineering (PEng) designation is either required or preferred where specified.

At the end of the semester, departmental procedures require sessional instructors to submit assessment data for undergraduate course learning outcomes (in connection with the CEAB Graduate Attribute Indicators, as dictated by the Faculty's Continual Improvement process). In addition, sessional instructors are also required to submit a second final exam that will be held on file in the department in the event that a supplemental exam is required after the sessional contract is complete. The evaluation data and final exam are to be submitted to the departmental secretary. Availability of future teaching opportunities may be negatively impacted by a failure to submit requested information on a timely basis.

All **returning applications**, with the exception of exemptions identified under Section 54:08 (a) of the WUFA Collective Agreement, are required to submit official teaching evaluations (SPT scores) or equivalent of all courses they have taught along with an updated CV. **New applicants** who have not taught previously in the Department are asked to include a cover letter identifying the course(s) applying for, a CV, three current letters of reference, teaching evaluations or equivalent for all courses they have taught, and the **Sessional Application Employment form**.

**Compensation:** Sessional rate of pay per R.1 (b):

Fall 2026: September 1, 2026 to December 31, 2026 - \$9,794 for Full Semester Courses.

The stipends are outlined in Article R.1 (b) of the current Collective Agreement with the Windsor University Faculty Association. The rates are inclusive of 4% vacation pay.
