

## 1 Remembering

Are you able to recall material you learned in the classroom through lectures or from conversations, or from books, articles and websites? Key verbs: *choose, define, find, label, list, locate, match, memorize, relate, select, state*

## 2 Understanding

If asked, can you explain concepts or ideas, particularly those of a complex or abstract nature? Key verbs: *classify, compare, contrast, describe, discuss, extend, identify, interpret, relate, summarize*

## 3 Applying

Can you solve problems in new ways using knowledge you have acquired and skills you have developed? Are your recommendations and solutions practical and implementable? Key verbs: *build, choose, construct, develop, model, organize, solve*

## 4 Analyzing

Do you know how to examine information by breaking it down into its constituent parts in order to make inferences or generalizations? Key verbs: *assume, classify, compare & contrast, divide, distinguish, inspect, question, test*

## 5 Evaluating

Are you confident in your position and able to defend it based on your earlier analysis? Key verbs: *agree, appraise, assess, criticize, decide, determine, disprove, explain, interpret, judge, justify, measure, perceive, prioritize, support, value*

## 6 Creating

Can you offer new solutions by combining different ideas into a new pattern or format? Key verbs: *adapt, assemble, compile, compose, construct, design, elaborate, formulate, modify, originate, propose*
