Blackboard Learn

The University of Windsor is using Blackboard Learn as its learning management system (LMS). Blackboard Learn is a proven solution which enables instructors and students to utilize an enriched and diverse, integrated technological environment for their teaching and learning activities and it can serve as a digital hub for coursework. Blackboard Learn significantly enhances our capacity to offer engaging, high-quality online and blended learning and teaching, and allows for greater support for instructors pursuing new pedagogical approaches. The campus will be primarily online in Fall 2020 due to the COVID-19 Pandemic, so Blackboard will play a big role in sustaining our academic goals.

Blackboard is:

- **Customizable:** Provides customization options to support a range of pedagogical styles, site organization, personal notifications, and adaptive release of materials.
- **Interactive:** Enables instructors to connect and engage with students through blogs, rich video, audio, virtual classrooms, and discussion board options using desktops, laptops, tablets, and smart phones.
- **Intuitive:** Includes extensive online help documentation and videos 24/7/365 to help users find about how to use features.
- **Efficient:** Offers extensive options for providing student feedback and integrated grading.

Getting Training

Training for instructors and assistants is available through synchronous/real-time workshops at uwindsor.ca/bbworkshops or in online, self-paced, non-facilitated courses by Blackboard at uwindsor.ca/bbonline. Register for a session that is right for you and your needs. Synchronous Workshops

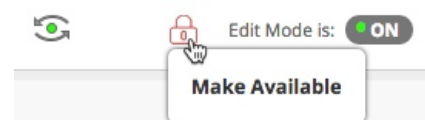

- **Bb Decaf** - This option will offer a relaxed, and slower-paced workshop by placing an emphasis on step-by-step learning. This category is suitable for the emerging technical explorer or the learner who is new to using learning management systems.
- **Bb Espresso** - This option will offer a fast-paced more technically driven workshop. This category is suitable for the learner who is confident using learning management system tools, or other online systems, who possesses a high comfort level in learning and adopting new technology.
- **Bb Café Virtual Help Desk** – Stop by to get your quick questions answered or to find out where more information can be available by visiting the Bb Café Organization site. Getting Started FAQ's

How do I get my course site?

Blackboard and the **UWinsite Student (Student Information System - SIS)** are integrated. Therefore, an automatic process gets initiated once your course code is entered into the SIS, and you are connected to that course in the SIS as the **Instructor of Record**. Once that occurs, a script runs to automatically create an empty "Course Shell." This shell is not available to students until you make it available.

Clicking the “red lock icon” will open your site to students (if the date you activate falls within the default dates for the term). If during non-standard times before the term, you will need to follow a few more steps – submit a ticket at uwindsor.ca/bbhelp and we will send you the instructions!

Where will I find my courses?

You will see your newly created courses when you log in to Blackboard at <http://blackboard.uwindsor.ca>. Courses are seen at the top of the Blackboard site under the **Courses** tab, or when you are on the **Home** tab, they appear in **My Courses**. Also, they can also be seen from the **Global Navigation** drop-down list up by your name in the top right corner of the Blackboard site. The course will appear with the course code, and the course name.

What happens if I don't have a course shell yet?

Chances are, the information hasn't made it into the SIS yet, and you might want to contact your Departmental Support staff to see if that step has been taken care of. Once that happens, your course shell usually appears within 24 hours. If you still don't see it, then you will need to submit a Service Request with your course specifics to uwindsor.ca/bbhelp to follow up. Instructors also receive automatically, a Sandbox site to practice and learn in.

How does my course site get closed?

Courses will be automatically closed to students by the first day of the next semester. You won't need to do anything to your course site to disable student access. Your instructional team will continue to have access to the course site through the Courses tab, but it will be unavailable to students. If you have a special circumstance where you need to keep the site open, please submit a Service Request via uwindsor.ca/bbhelp containing course details (name, section, number, your UWin ID, as well as the length you need it open for). We will send you instructions on how to enable extended access.
