Student Needs/Challenges Timeline



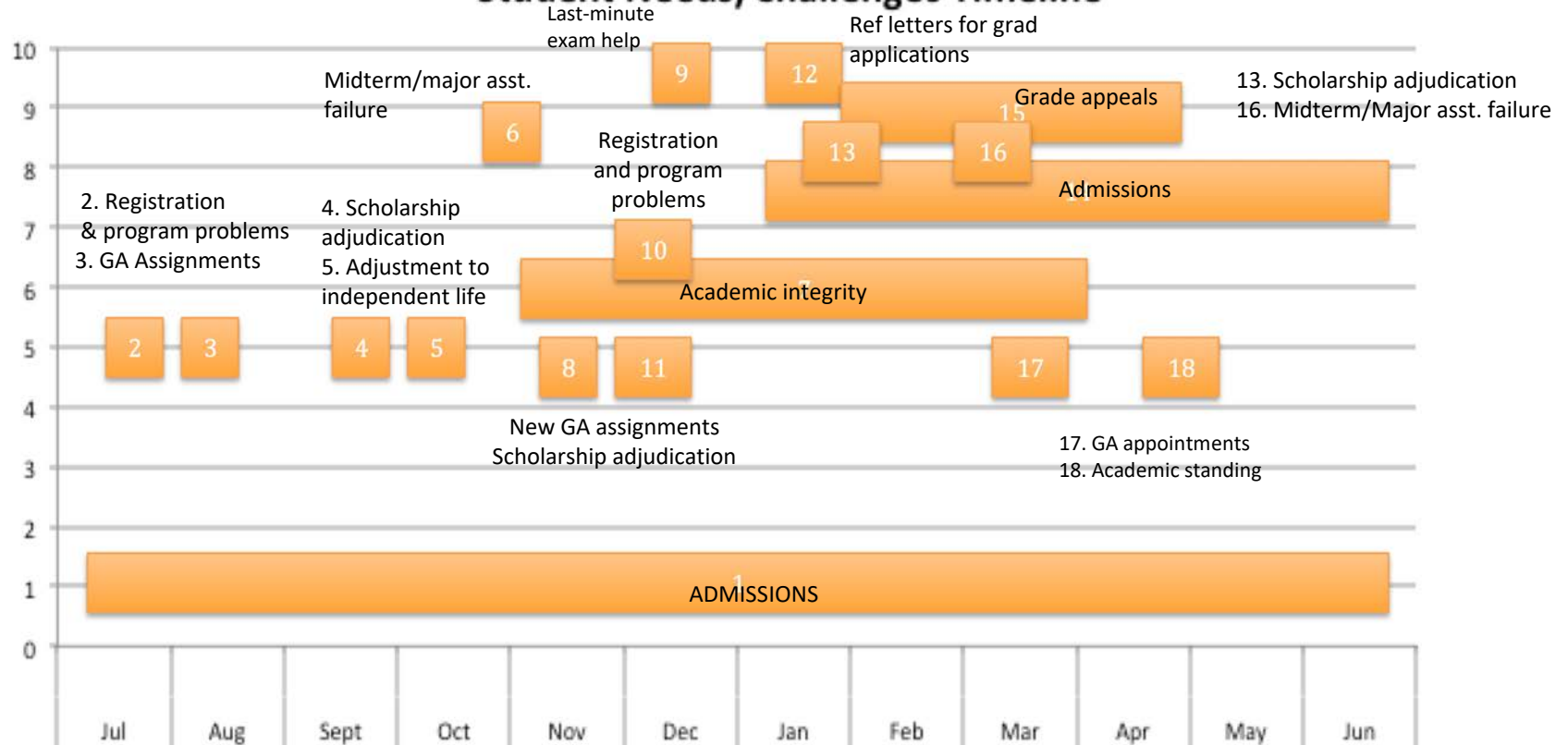

Student Needs/Challenges Timeline

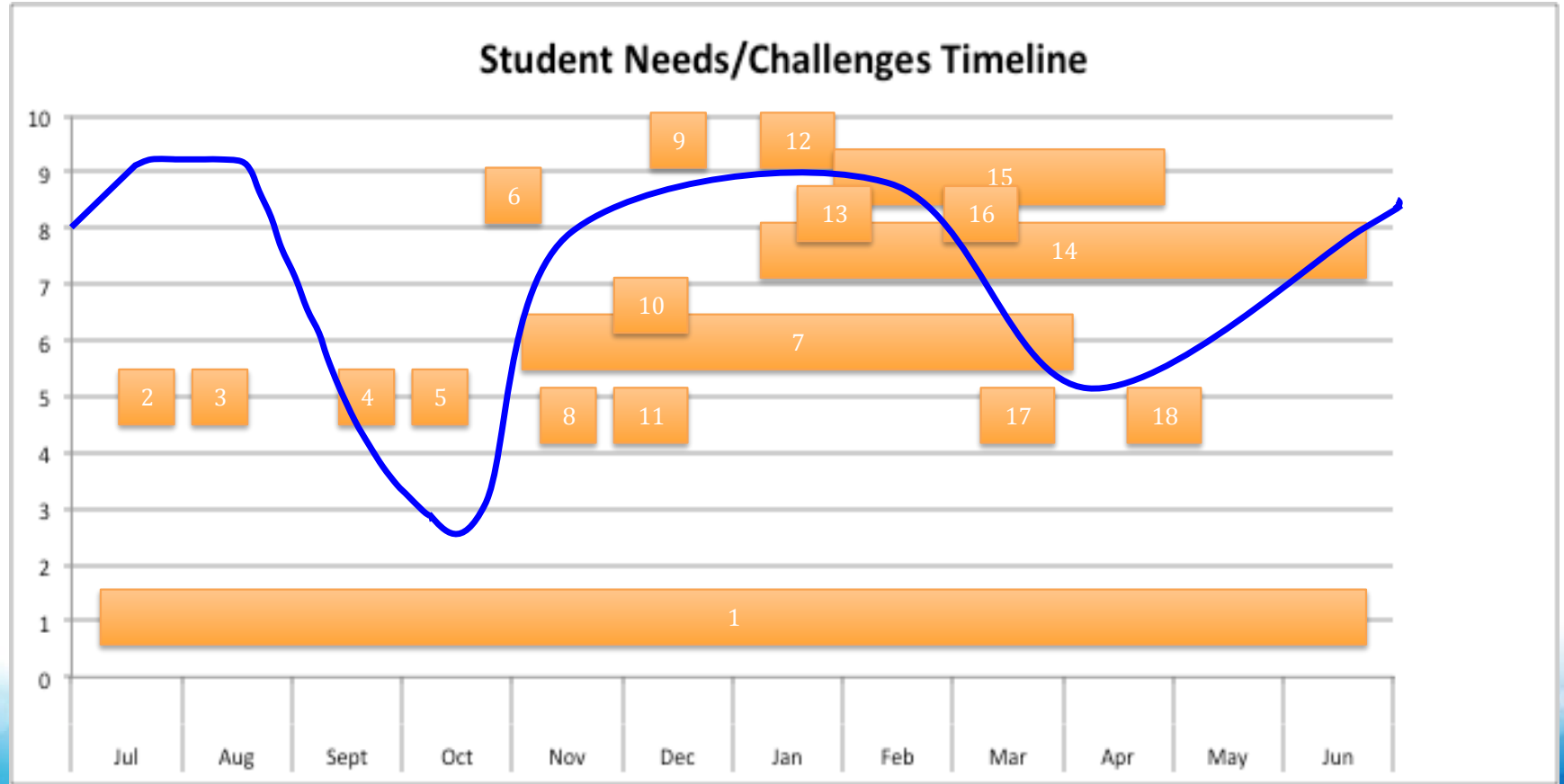
