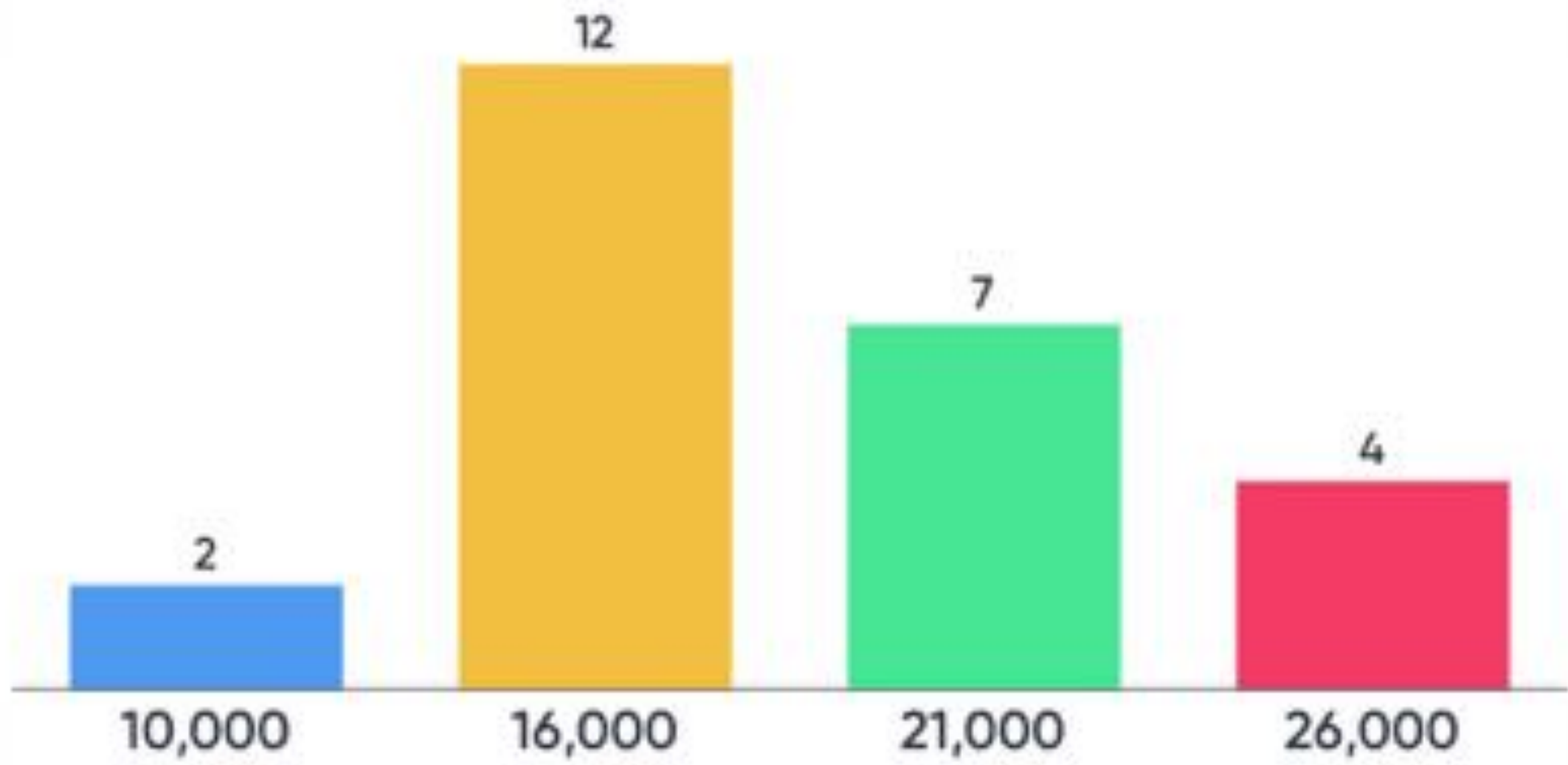

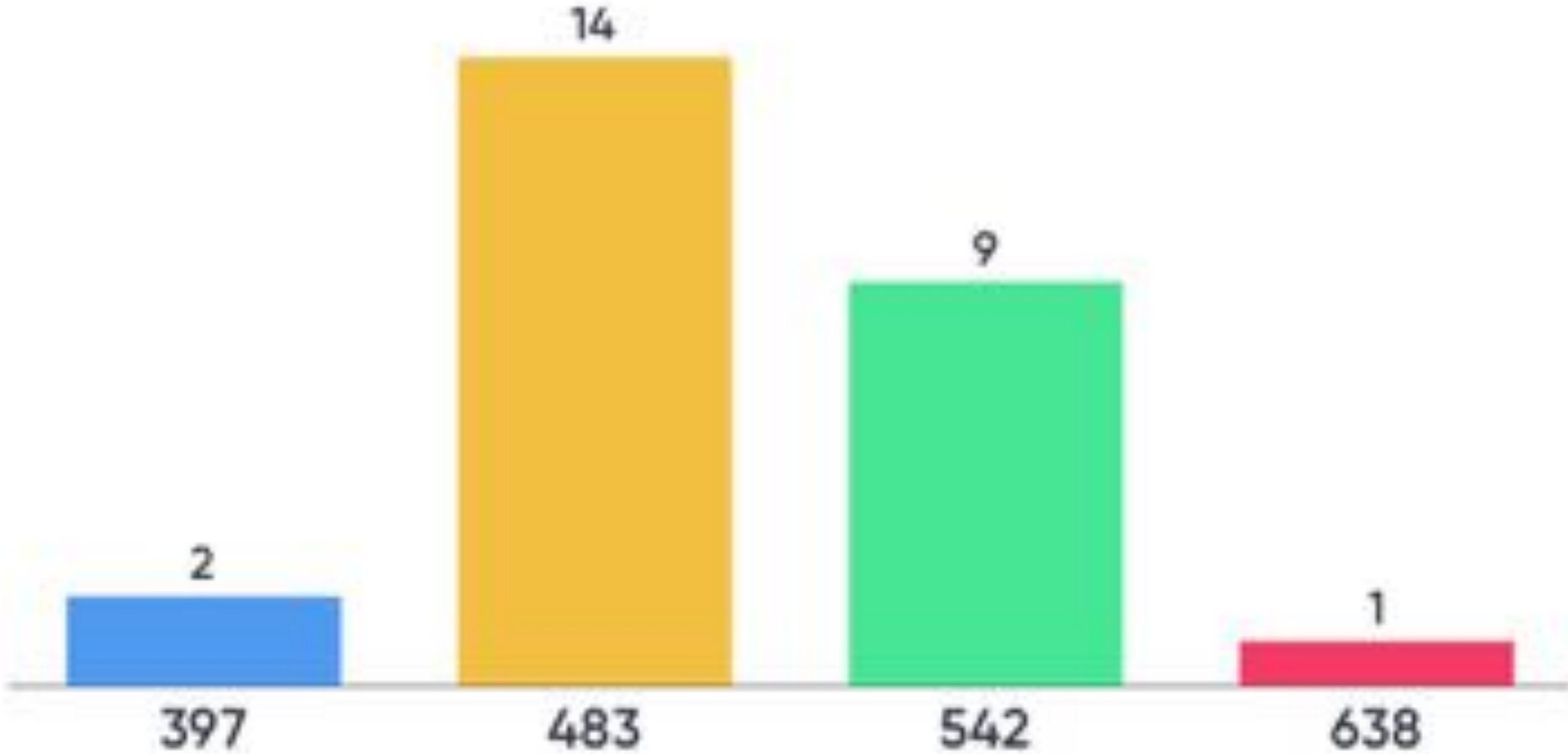

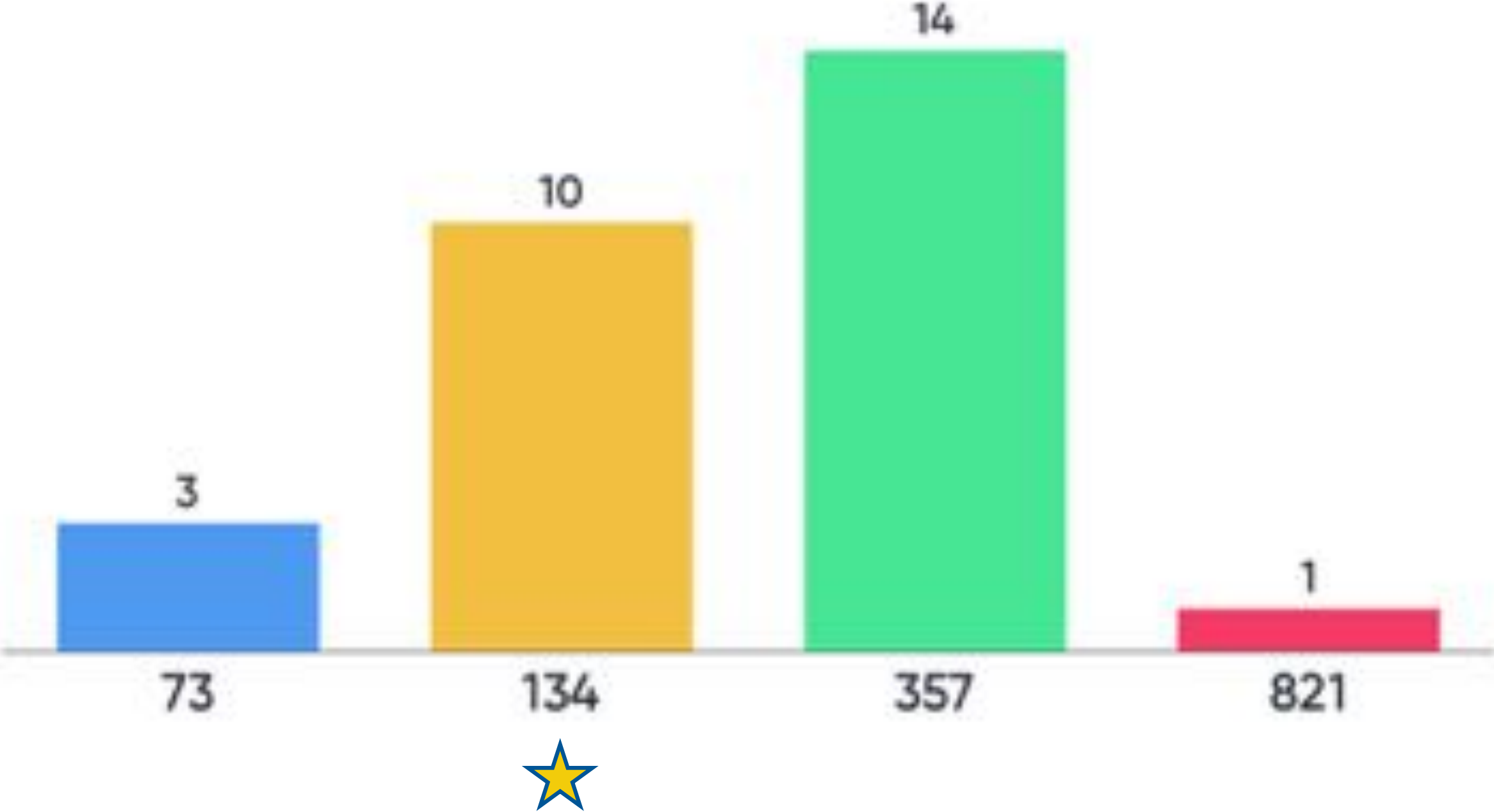
UWindsor's total student population?



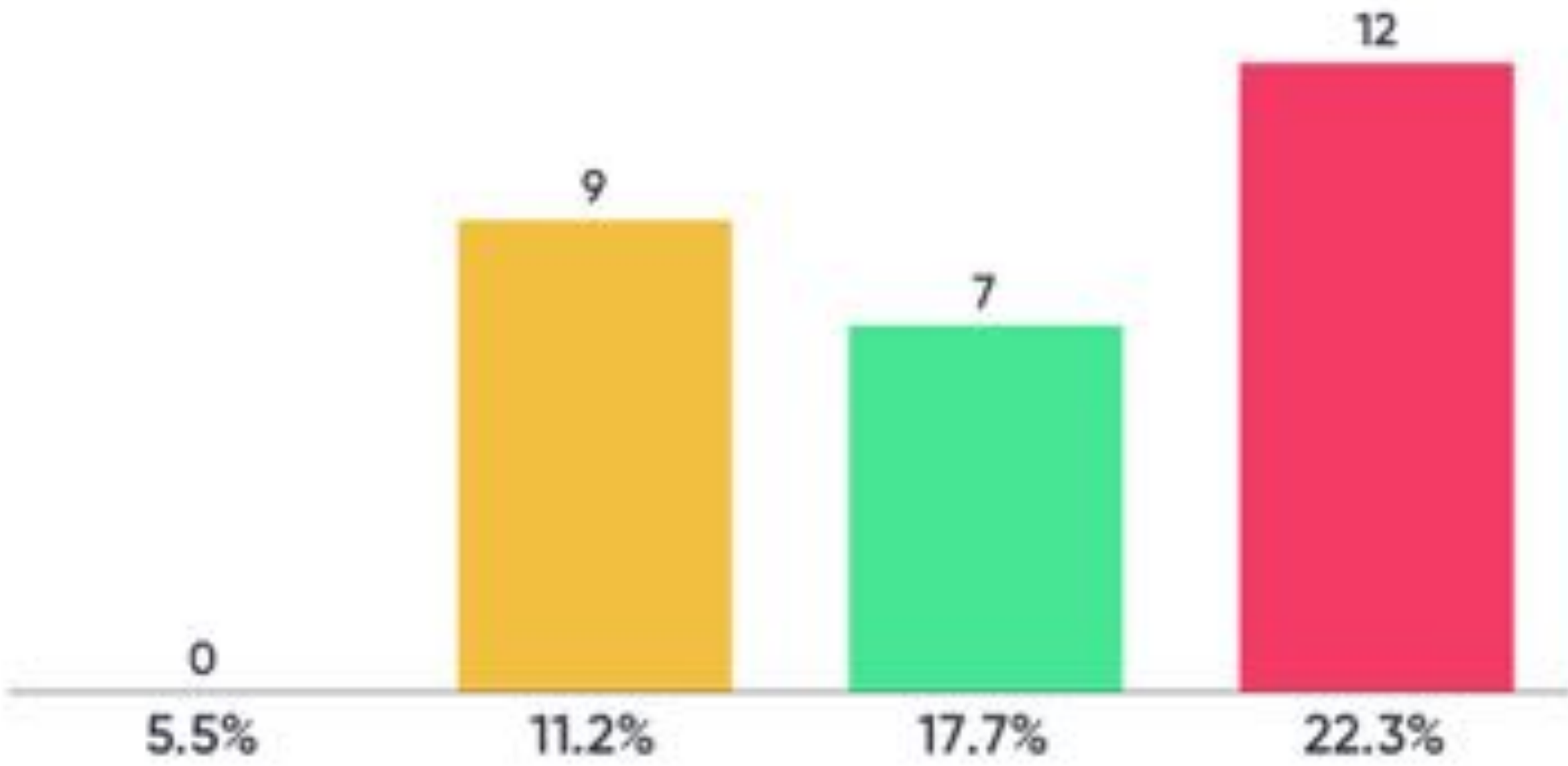
Total number of tenure-track and tenured faculty at UWindsor?



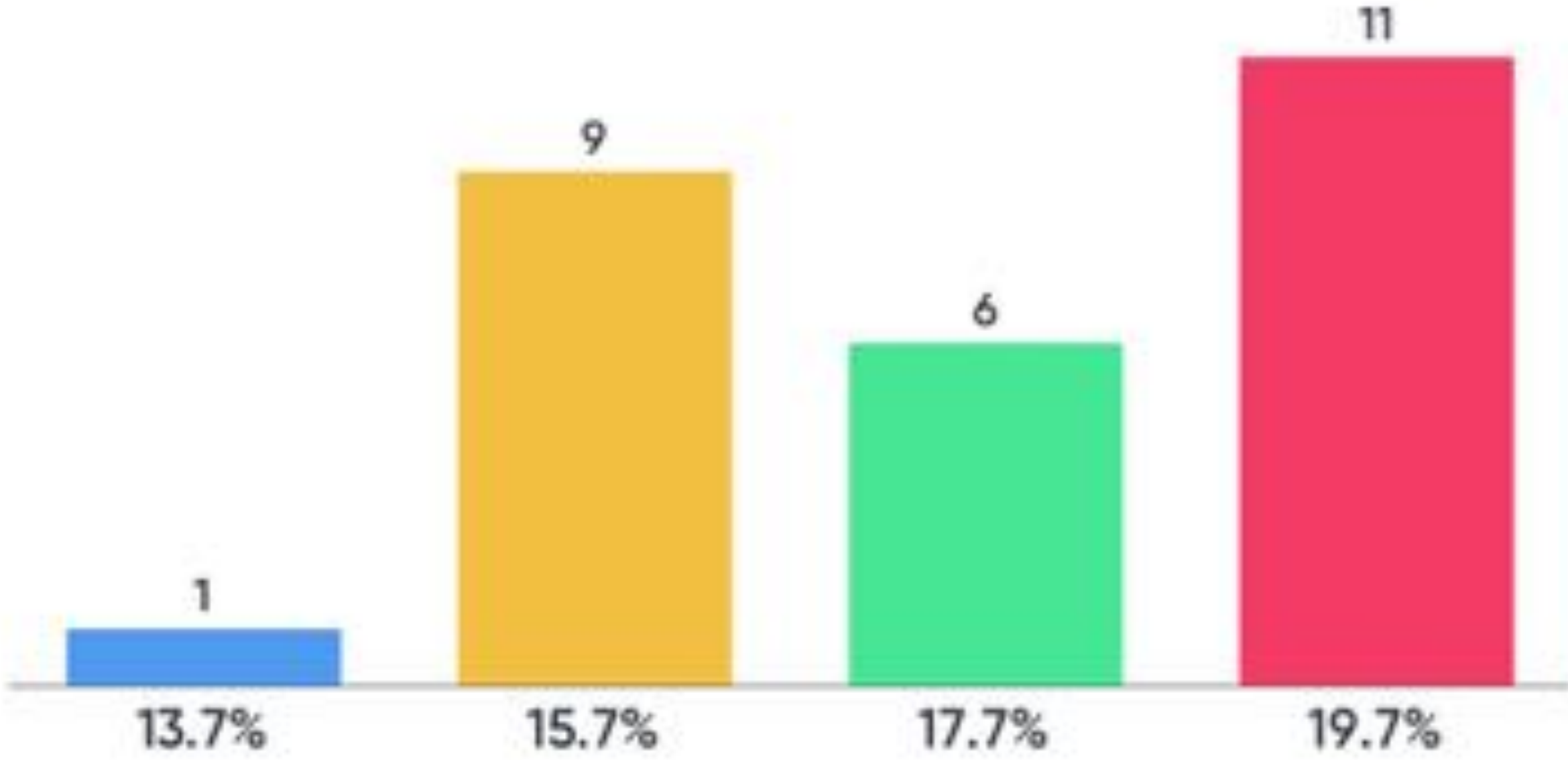
Number of UWindsor students who self-identify as Indigenous?



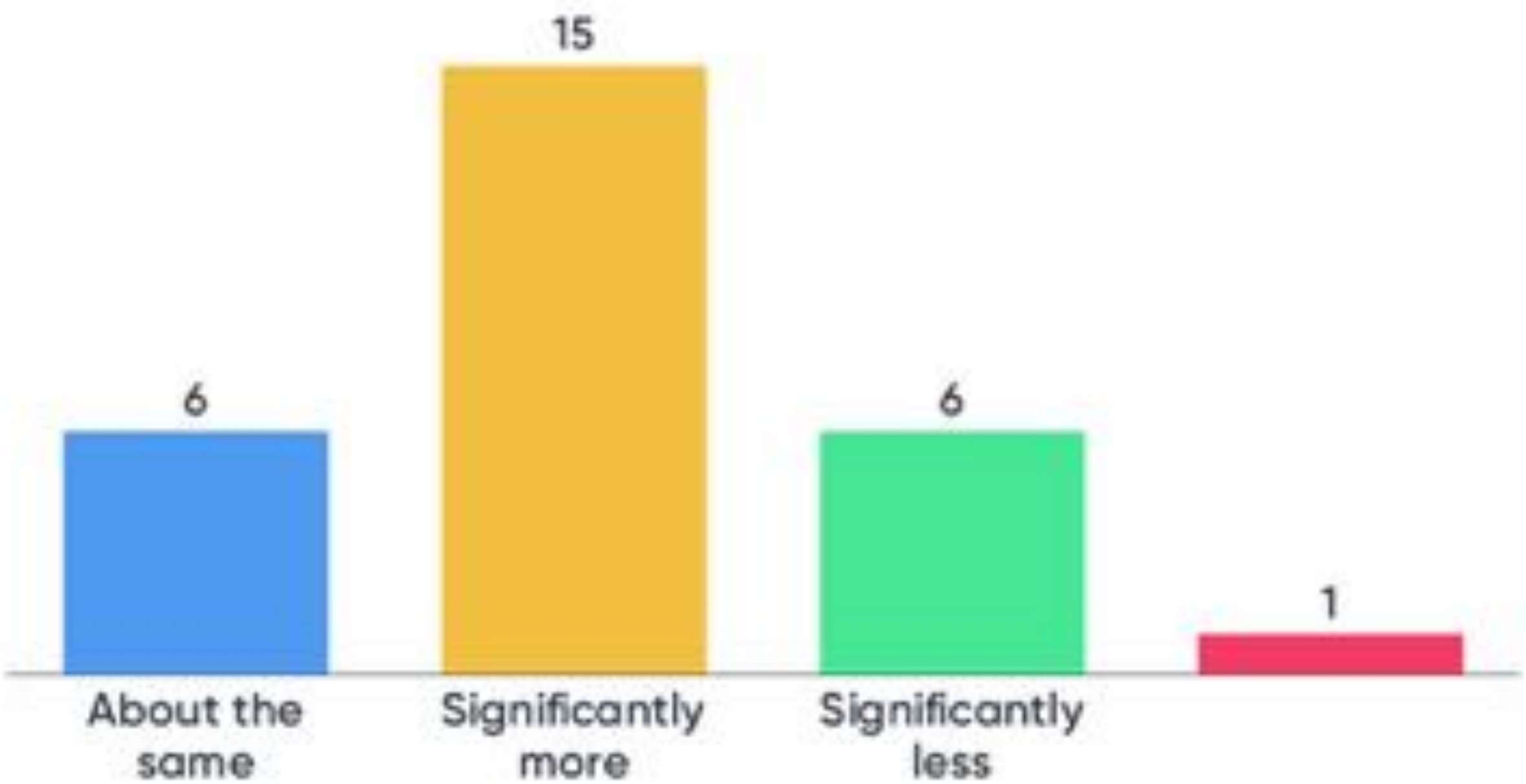
Percentage of UWindsor students who come from outside Canada?



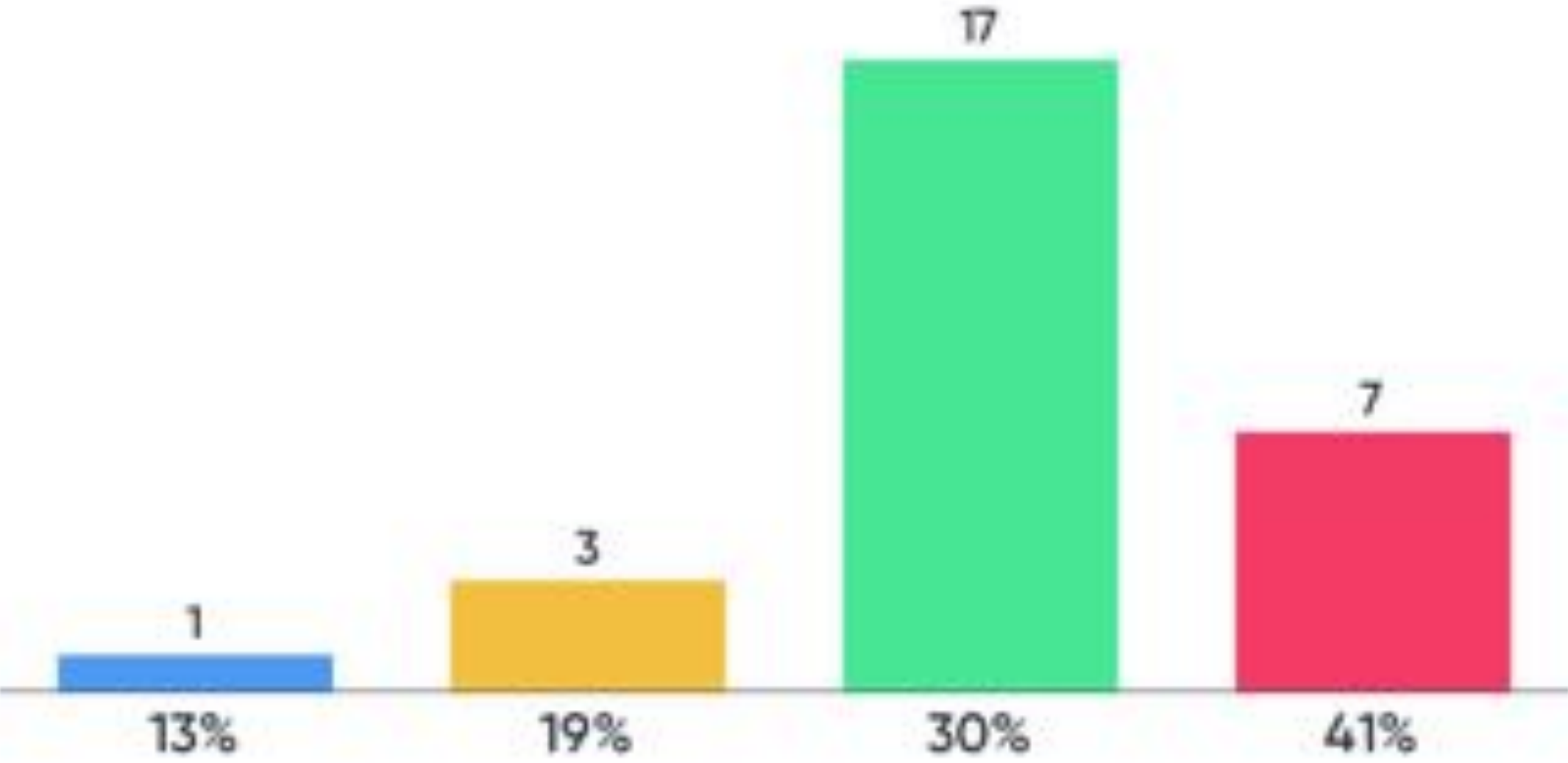
What percentage of UWindsor faculty come from outside Canada?



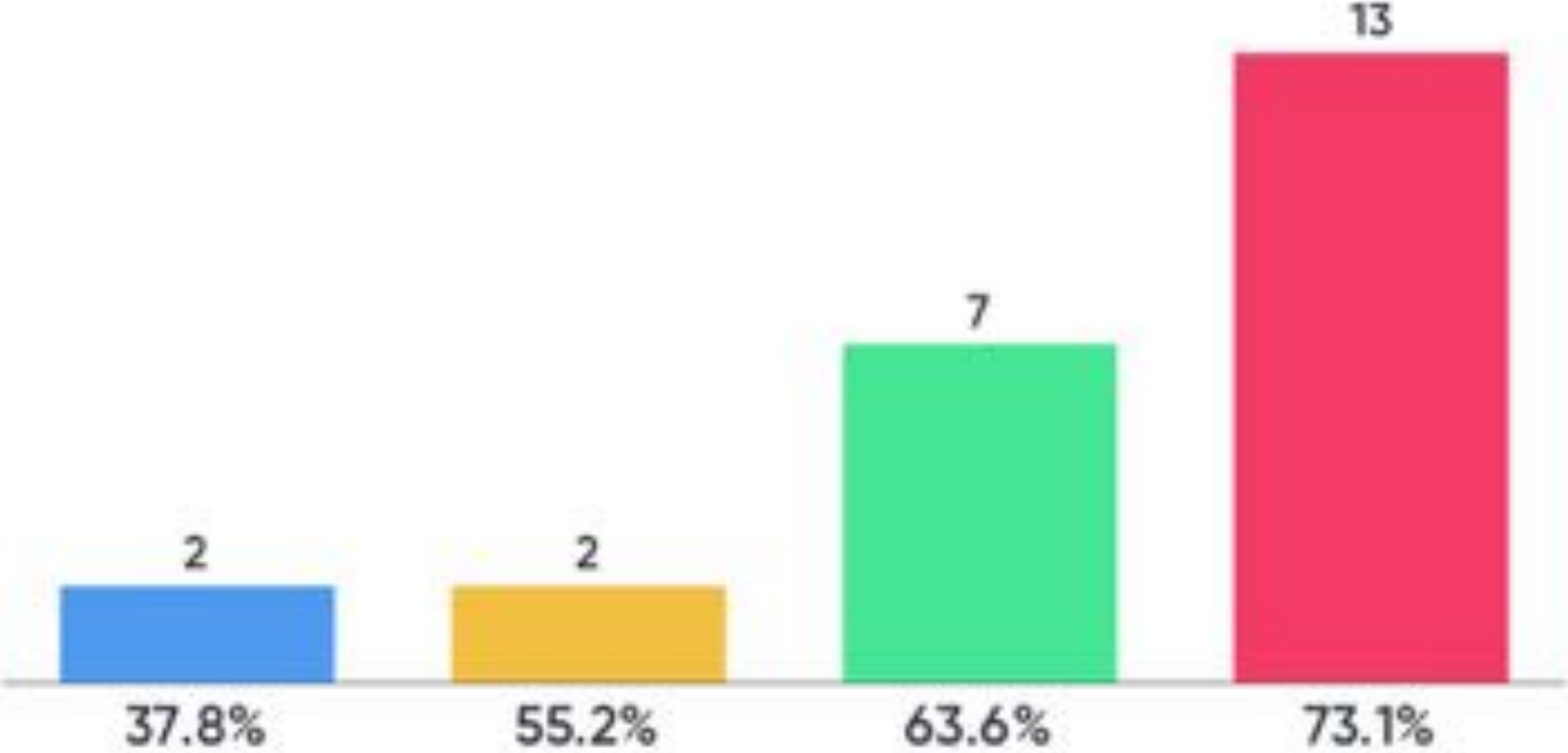
Fourth-year students at UWin report that they work an average of 11.3 hours per week. How does that compare to their peers other ON universities?

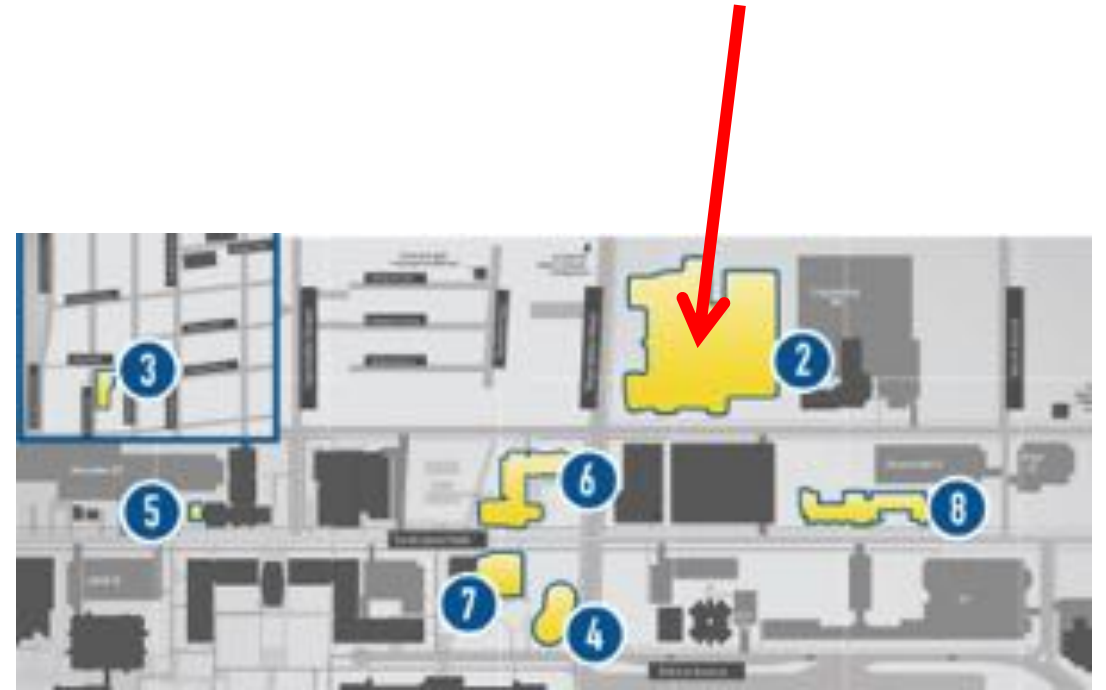

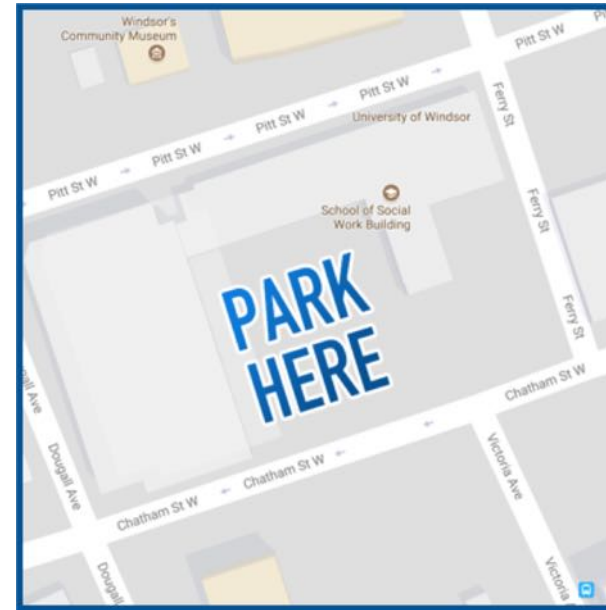
