## Reasons to do (institutional) service

- 1. Because you have to! (20% expectation)
  - a. 40% teaching, 40% research, 20% service
  - b. Be aware of how your service is evaluated at each level of promotion/tenure by reviewing your Faculty's RTP criteria
- 2. To contribute to the operation of your unit/AAU/Faculty/University
- 3. To find out what it takes to be successful in research, promotion, tenure, etc.
- 4. To network with those who will decide your future, people you will collaborate with, etc.
- 5. To make you a more effective member of the UWindsor community

## Strategies about selecting (*institutional*) service opportunities will build on the aforementioned reasons

- Don't be afraid to ask the advice of one or more mentors in your AAU about strategic service that is relevant to your field of practice
- Watch for emails about university-level service opportunities that align with your preferences
- Consider sitting on committees that will help build skill sets or expose you to content that may help you later

## Discipline-specific *community* service may also be quite important

- May relate to outreach for your discipline
- Provides a connection with community/corporate research partners
- Network may provide employment opportunities for recent graduates in your discipline
- Networking may lead to input contributing to academic program development
