



SUPPORTING STUDENTS WITH ACCESSIBILITY NEEDS

Student Accessibility Services (SAS) is an educational support program for students who require academic accommodation for a permanent or temporary disability. In addition to letters of accommodation, Advisors in SAS support students by advising, them, referring them to other relevant campus services, and facilitating their access to necessary supports.





ACADEMIC ACCOMODATIONS

Academic accommodations are put in place to equalize learning opportunities and access to the academic environment for students with disabilities. The functional limitations resulting from a disability can at times intersect with the academic environment in a

way that creates a barrier for students.
Advisors work with students to determine what barriers they are experiencing specific to their disability and what accommodations would equalize the learning environment for them.
