The Triple Gymnasium

features industry-favoured flooring able to support a magnitude of activities. It was built to serve the needs of a variety of user groups in the campus and Windsor-Essex community.

- Host to intramural sport, recreation activities, community tournaments, special events and varsity basketball and volleyball teams
- Modern varsity changerooms with direct access to the triple gymnasium

- Retractable seating for 2,000

The Pool

features a modern, Myrtha pool renowned for marrying form, function and innovation. The largest community space in the building, the pool area will host a variety of programs for all ages and skill levels including lap and recreational swim, aqua fitness, lessons and more.

- Over 9,150 sq. ft. 8-lane, 25-metre pool
- 8 diving platforms
- Accessible zero-entry ramp
- Accessible showers, change rooms and washrooms with secure lockers including an universal area
- Natural lighting and retractable solar screens
- On-deck spectator viewing area for up to 20
- 45% reduction in green house gases



The Fitness Centre

features topline equipment to help meet the community's health and wellness goals.

- Additional 13,000 sq. ft. spanning two floors
- 2 levels of floor-to-ceiling windows
- 3 new multi-purpose spaces can host spin cycle, martial arts, high-intensity interval training (HIIT) classes and act as a functional training room
- 16 touch-screen treadmills, 4 touch-screen step mills, 16 bikes (including 4 assault bikes), 4 touch-screen ellipticals
- Full complement of free weights
- Top-of-the-line strength training equipment — tripling the number of cardio and strength training equipment currently available
- Olympic bars and bumper plates, battle ropes, upper and lower body ergometers



Outdoor Spaces

have been expanded and updated:

- 2 new outdoor soccer fields refurbished with natural grass, west field will feature LED lighting
- New cricket pitch, portable equipment cages and benches
- Paved multi-use outdoor recreational trail with LED lighting, interlocking walkways and greenery.
- 189 parking spaces
- 4 EVCO vehicle charging stations
