ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT TERMS

ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT	Module used to track the requirements a student must satisfy in order to graduate.
ACADEMIC PROGRESS	Student View of Advisement Report
ADVISEMENT REPORT	Degree audit report that displays a student's progress toward graduation. Can be viewed online or as a PDF document.
ADVISEMENT REPORT TYPES	ADV – Academic Advisement Report NOIP – Excludes in-progress courses REQ – Enroll by Requirements WHIF – What-If Advisement Report
REQUIREMENT GROUPS	[RG] – Major or Minor
ACADEMIC REQUIREMENTS	[RQ] – Academic Requirements
REQUIREMENT LINES	[LN] – Specifies or limits requirements
COURSE LIST	[CL] – Specifies courses or may be wildcard
ADMIT TERM	Term student was admitted to university
REQUIREMENT TERM	Indicates Calendar student is following
ACADEMIC LEVEL	Year of Study
TERM HISTORY	Term Stats, Cum Stats, Academic Standing
ACADEMIC STANDING	GOOD – In Good Standing PROB – Academic Probation RTW – Required to Withdraw
STUDENT EXCEPTIONS	Course Directive – substitute course Requirement Waiver – waive requirement
CAREER SIMULATION	What-if scenario for student changing majors, adding a minor, or adding a sub-plan.
GRADE POINT AVERAGE REQUIREMENTS	Required GPA for cumulative and major average for student to continue in program and be eligible for graduation.
