BA (Hons) in Liberal Arts and Professional Studies: Aeronautics Leadership Program Requirements and Optional Course Sequencing

Below you will find recommended course sequencing in order to complete the degree. Courses highlighted **yellow** are required. Courses highlighted **turquoise** are highly recommended. The rest of the sequencing indicates all other general requirements in a suggested order. However, this order can be changed to suit the student.

You may also take less courses some semesters, and more courses other semesters and therefore this schedule might not be exactly your experience. If you have concerns about the courses you are taking or would like to make sure your degree is on track, always feel free to set up an advising meeting with me.

Please remember that you can **only take fourteen 1000 level (first-year) courses** throughout your degree.

Here is a simple breakdown of your requirements:

- 40 courses (or 120 units) to graduate
 - 8 courses (or 24 units) from Flight
 - 8 courses (or 24 units) from Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences
 - 6 courses (or 18 units) from Leadership stream (see Program Requirements for list of options)
 - 4 courses (or 12 units) from Science, Engineering, or Computer Science
 - 3 courses (or 9 units) from Business (see Program Requirements for list of required courses)
 - 2 courses (or 6 units) from Effective Writing
 - 9 courses (or 27 units) from any area of study
