

SENATE POLICY

Gateway Policy

(Senate-approved: June 10, 2010)

(Amended Due to New Course Numbering: January 1, 2019)

Through its alternate admissions Gateway Program, the Faculty of Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences will recommend for admission selected students whose high school grade averages range between 60 and 69. Gateway Program student admits will be required to complete successfully GART-1200 Understanding the Contemporary World and GART-1500 Foundations of Academic Writing before proceeding to other courses and programs.

*This policy replaces any other admission policy for students admitted to FAHSS whose high school grade averages are below 70%.
