

## **SENATE POLICY**

## **Policy on Introductory Statistics Courses**

(Inception as common University-wide policy: 2000-2001 (Undergraduate Calendar))

(AMENDED by Senate: 09 Dec 2016)

(Amended Due to New Course Numbering: January 1, 2019)

This policy applies to the following introductory statistics courses:

Human Kinetics KINE-2690 Measurement and Evaluation,

Engineering GENG-2220 Engineering Treatment of Experimental Data,

Business MSCI-2020 Business Data Analysis,

Science STAT-2910 Statistics for the Sciences, and

FAHSS SOSC-2500 Basic Quantitative Methods in Social Sciences.

Students will normally take the course offered by their own Faculty.

In light of the Senate Policy on Course Equivalencies, the following substitutes may be made:

- 1. SOSC-2500 is a substitute for KINE-2690 and vice versa.
- 2. SOSC-2500 is a substitute for MSCI-2020.
- 3. KINE-2690 is a substitute for MSCI-2020.
- 4. MSCI-2020, together with its pre-requisite 73-100, can be substituted for one of either KINE-2690 or SOSC-2500.
- 5. GENG-2220 can be substituted for one of either MSCI-2020, KINE-2690 or SOSC-2500.
- 6. STAT-2910 can be substituted for one of either MSCI-2020, KINE-2690 or SOSC-2500.
- 7. The courses MSCI-2020, KINE-2690 and SOSC-2500 cannot be substituted for either GENG-2220 or STAT-2910.
- 8. STAT-2910 can be taken for credit subsequent to GENG-2220, MSCI-2020, KINE-2690, and SOSC-2500.
- 9. If GENG-2220 is taken subsequent to STAT-2910, credit will not be counted for both GENG-2220 and STAT-2910.
