

SENATE POLICY

Policy on Senior-Level Course Requirements

(Inception as common University-wide policy: December 17, 1997) (Amended: January 1, 2019 due to new course numbering)

Three-year degree programs require a minimum of sixteen courses at or above the 2000 level. All four-year programs require a minimum of twenty-six courses at or above the 2000 level. Consequently, no student will be able to count more than fourteen 1000-level courses towards a degree.
