Students who have been identified as Domestic – Outside of Ontario students for the purpose of tuition fee assessment, but feel that they should be eligible for the Domestic – Ontario tuition fee rates, can submit this form to have their eligibility reviewed. To be a resident of Ontario, a student is required to live in Ontario for a 12-month consecutive period without attending post-secondary students (college or university). Residency can also be based on a parent's or spouse's residential history where the parent/spouse did not attend college or university.

**Please submit completed form to** <u>finappeal@uwindsor.ca</u> by the following deadlines: Applications for appeals for Out of Province fees must be received by the following dates:

- Fall Term: October 31
- Winter Term: February 1
- Summer Term: June 30

Please provide supporting documents which show your name and mailing address for 12 months prior to May 2022 that verify you resided in Ontario.

Examples include: 2020-22 utility bills, property tax bill, copy of driver's license issued in 2021 or pay stubs. Please feel free to block information you deem private such as your SIN or pay amount, etc. Screenshots of this are acceptable.

Requests received after the deadline will be applied to the subsequent term, but will not be eligible for the current or past terms.
