Bird / Window Collisions

GENERAL ASSUMPTIONS

• Birds are importantfor the planet

Dead birds are important ...salvage for research

• Birds don't see glass ...transparent or reflective

Window collisions ...highly preventable

Decals* and noise makers ...DO NOT WORK

Action is required ...inaction doesn't make it better



^{*} Decals, stickers, silhouettes, decoys, etc - need such close spacing that they're never applied correctly

Bird / Window Collisions

ASSUMPTIONS FOR THIS STUDY

- Low rise buildings ...less than 12 floors, most <5
- Non-residential* buildings ...campus, office park, etc
- Diurnal collisions only ...midday surveys optimal
- Not a "lights out" issue ...at least not directly
- Not feeder related ...no feeders/few feeder species
- Not generally panic related ...maybe on occasion

^{*} Some dorms were surveyed







*highly variable, max known = 3,000


Extremely broad generalizations re: seasonal strike detection ratios based on problem MI buildings:

Spring = \sim 5-10+ Summer = \sim 5-15+ Fall = \sim 20-35+









Snapshot: Fall 2015 - Fall 2016

- Constants: vegetation, lighting, glass.
- "Bird deterrent" installed Spring 2016
- 117 strike detections for ~2 year span
 - Pre-F15 = ~32
 - \circ F15 = ~36
 - o SP16 = 9
 - **SU16 = 12**
 - o F16 = 28

Reminder: ~50% survive, ?% die elsewhere
