



Student Kinesiologist – Occupational Rehab Job Description

This internship position includes working directly with a Registered Kinesiologist in an outpatient clinic setting and completing the full duties of the Kinesiologist under supervision. The clinic is a multidisciplinary clinic including physiotherapists, occupational therapists, and vestibular therapists, there is a strong focus on neurology related complaints like concussions, strokes, and genetic neurological conditions.

For all duties, the student will be supervised by the Registered Kinesiologist. The duties of the student will include:

- Perform biomechanical, physical, and functional assessments, including Functional Capacity Evaluations
- Design, implement and supervise graded exercise programs
- Record and progress functional programs regularly
- Attend and participate in weekly case conferences with the team as one of the primary treating therapists
- Work cooperatively with clients and third party funders to achieve specific goals
- Communicating with appropriate referral sources and stakeholders
- Conduct group orientation and education sessions and ongoing one-on-one education to clients
- Complete reporting requirements for initial, progress and discharge reports with input from all applicable team members
- Treating out-patient injuries including but not limited to: joints, soft tissue sprains and strains, post-operative rehab, post-concussion management, back and neck pain, knee and ankle pain, shoulder dysfunction, and balance issues
- Developing individualized treatment plans based on analysis and clinical reasoning
- Focusing on health promotion, ergonomics, fitness training, and return to work strategies
- Utilizing e-charting software to document treatment sessions and recommendations
