Interession 2022 May 9-June 21	KINE-2300-1 Sociology of Sport and Physical Activities MTWR 8:30 a.m. – 9:50 a.m. In Person (Hy-Flex)	An examination of the relationship between sport and society from a variety of perspectives. This examination will include the interaction of sport with other societal institutions and with various social determinants.
Summer Session 2022 June 27-Aug. 10	KINE-2100-1 Human Performance MTWR 10:00 a.m. – 11:20 a.m. In Person (Hy-Flex)	An examination of the role perception and cognition play in our ability to sense, attend to, process, and transmit information during the performance of any motor skill. The course will focus on an information processing approach to examine the processes that underlie our ability to perform motor skills.
	KINE-2500-1 Organizational Behaviour MTWR 8:30 a.m. – 9:50 a.m. In Person (Hy-Flex)	An introduction to the social psychological parameters of sport administration. This course will focus upon the integration of decision-making, communication, administrative behaviour, motivation, satisfaction, authority, conflict, etc., as each interacts and contributes to improve the effectiveness of the administrative process.
	KINE-4890-2 / 4900-2 Race in Sport MTWR 1:00 p.m. – 2:20 p.m. In Person (Hy-Flex)	This course will explore the complex, diverse, and multidimensional (e.g., gender, class, religion) intersectionality of race and racialization in sport with a particular emphasis on, but not limited to, sport in North America and the participants (athletes, coaches, owners), governing bodies, spectators, and communities in which sport occurs.
	KINE-4470-1 Outdoor Recreation In Person	Through guided discovery and experiential learning, this course provides knowledge about the outdoors as an alternative recreational medium that fosters deeper awareness of nature, wilderness, and ourselves. Offered in the Fall term before the start of classes. (Prerequisite: demonstrated swimming competence.) (Additional fee applies.)
